We anticipate construction will be complete in **Spring 2017**.

### **Construction Progress**

Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R), Under Armour, and Fields Inc. are making incredible progress on the renovated field and track at Duniway Park.

To date; the concrete work, drainage systems, pedestrian lighting, synthetic turf, and throwing and jumping facilities are nearing completion.

**Your new Duniway Park track & field will be a fantastic modern amenity.**



### **Delay**

It has been a **very busy** building and construction season in Portland Oregon. This has limited construction supplies, placed pressure on the city's permitting bureau to provide permits, and constrained contractor's availability. Because our construction schedule shifted into the colder and wetter months, we are now encountering weather related delays.





### **Track Surfacing**

Building a high quality surface for track users to walk and run on involves:

- Laying an asphalt base
- Several days of dry weather for the asphalt base to dry
- Applying three additional layers of surfacing to create the cushioning. This also must be done under dry conditions

**The construction site for the track & field at Duniway Park will remain closed to the public until Spring 2017 to allow time for the installation of the track surfacing.**

### **Please help us build a great facility!**

We need your help to build your new high quality facility. Please stay out of the active construction site until the fences are removed in **Spring 2017**. The track surface must stay clean between applications of the surfacing in order to maintain the structural integrity of the new track surface material.
