ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES
FY 2018/19**

ROLE

- The BAC represents a diversity of expertise, skills, and viewpoints. As such, committee members are expected to listen carefully and consider the range of local and citywide needs and goals; and fully participate in all BAC meetings. Committee recommendations should represent a broad base of collective wisdom about what will best serve our city and the local neighborhood.
- The recommendations, suggestions and advice of the BAC will be provided to the PP&R staff, the Director of Portland Parks & Recreation and Commissioner Fritz for consideration. Final decisions regarding the PP&R FY 2018-19 Requested Budget will be made by Commissioner Fritz.

RESPONSIBILITIES

DEVELOPING RECOMMENDATION

The BAC will work to reach agreement on advice and recommendations. The group will use a consensus process that respects the perspectives and contributions of all members. Whenever possible, the group will forward recommendations that are supported by the full group. If full agreement is not possible, the BAC will use a two-thirds majority vote to finalize recommendations. In the case of a majority vote, minority reports will be accepted and submitted along with the BAC recommendation.

GROUND RULES

- Arrive on time and be prepared for the meeting topics.
- Follow the topics and time set by the agenda.
- Listen carefully and speak honestly.
- Respect the views and opinions of others.
- Keep an open mind.
- Critique issues, not people or organizations.
- Allow space for everyone to participate - step up, step back
- Use discussion to clarify information
- Consider the needs and concerns of the local community and the larger city.
