## AN EASTSIDE PARK WITH CYCLISTS IN MIND

**Gateway Green** is a new park for off-road cycling, and other outdoor recreation in East Portland. Located just east of Rocky Butte, between the I-205 and I-84 freeways, near the Gateway Transit Center.

Opened in June 2017, this destination for mountain-biking, hiking, and outdoor exploration offers activities for people of all abilities. The Dirt Lab features bike trails, a pump track, and bike skills area.

Visitors from nearby neighborhoods and beyond can now enjoy this recreation area and green space with connections to the I-205 multi-use path.

Our growing team of community partners includes **Friends of Gateway Green**, the **Northwest Trails Alliance**, and the **Community Cycling Center**.

Funding for park improvements includes a *Nature in Neighborhoods*

grant from Metro to support major habitat restoration work. Additional funds come from System Development Charges for Parks, Trails, and Natural Areas.

Efforts are underway to develop other recreational activities beyond cycling features, protect and restore natural habitat, and improve access to and within the park.

We are working with the community to create a comprehensive park design. The community-supported design will guide improvements to the park, with construction expected to begin in late 2018.
