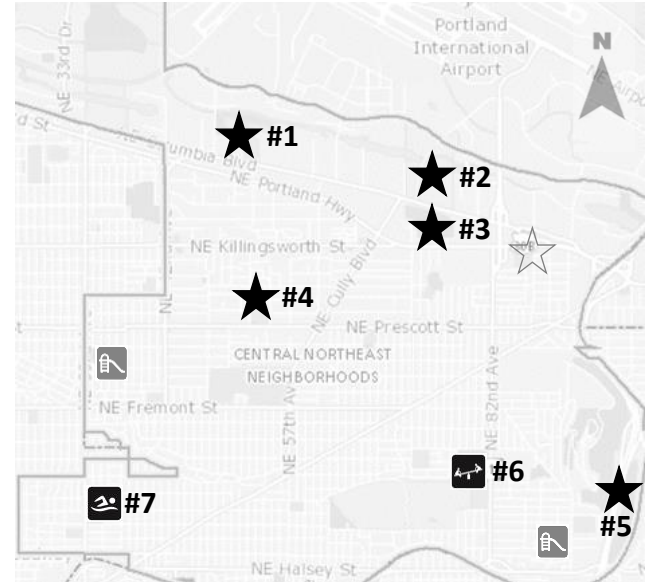


INVESTMENTS IN CENTRAL NORTHEAST NEIGHBORHOODS, INC. ANNOUNCED 2013-2018

August 2018 | Since 2013, Commissioner Amanda Fritz and Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) have allocated **over \$33M in park planning and capital investments in the Central Northeast Neighborhoods (CNN) coalition area.** Funded by System Development Charges (SDCs), the Parks Replacement Bond (Bond), General Fund (GF), and in some cases matched by other partners, these investments grow, improve access to, or help maintain PP&R parks, facilities, and trails. CAPITAL PROJECTS, ACQUISITIONS & PLANNING ★

#1 WHITAKER PONDS NATURE PARK ENTRY

Completed: Spring 2018

Investment: \$2.3M (\$1.87M SDCs, \$422K Metro)

Info: Construction of new entry off NE 47th avenue and frontage improvements.



#2 COLWOOD GOLF CENTER ACQUISITION & REDEVELOPMENT

Completed: 2017

Investment: \$4.5M acquisition (\$3.5M SDCs, \$1M East MultCo. Soil District) + \$3.5M development (\$1.1M Golf Fund, \$2.4M SDCs)

Info: Purchased 85 acres and refurbished site. Now PP&R operates 48 acres as a golf facility; remaining 37 acres are being restored as a natural area.



#3 THOMAS CULLY – NEW PARK LED BY VERDE

Completed: June 2018

Investment: \$13.7M (\$7.7M SDCs, \$6M Verde raised in grants, donations, partnerships)

Info: 25-acre development turning a brownfield into a park. Includes paths, playground, inter-tribal gathering area, youth soccer field, dog off-leash area, parking lot, & redevelopment of NE 72nd Ave. Project initiated by Commissioner Nick Fish.



#4 K^HUNAMOKWST – NEW PARK

Completed: April 2015

Investment: \$2.3M SDCs

Info: 2.1-acre park with playground, splash pad, skate park, loo, lighting, site furnishings, shelter and right-of-way improvements.



#5 GATEWAY GREEN ACQUISITION & DEVELOPMENT

Status: Phase 1—Completed Summer 2017 | Phase 2 & 3—Pending Spring 2019

Investment: \$6.2M (\$5.2M SDCs, \$1M Metro)

Info: In partnership with Friends of Gateway Green, Metro, and other funding partners, an off-road cycling trails and a mountain-biking destination. Note: park entrance in EPNO, development in CNN.



BOND PROJECTS

#6 GLENHAVEN PARK (PLAYGROUND+)

Expected Completion: Fall 2019

Investment: \$1.7M (\$1.45M Bond, \$250K SDCs)

Info: New playground, accessible pathway improvements, and public art.



#7 GRANT POOL

Completed: Summer 2016

Investment: \$2.16M Bond

Info: Mechanical systems replacement and pool deck accessibility improvements.
