Autumn Gold Ginkgo (male) <i>Ginkgo biloba</i> 'Autumn Gold'	50-60 ft	25-30 ft.	Full sun		Classic Ginkgo leaf. Intense yellow fall color.
Dawn redwood <i>Metasequoia glyptostroboides</i>	70-90 ft.	20-30 ft.	Full sun, prefers moist soil		Deciduous conifer. Truly unique. Feathery, fern-like foliage is soft to the touch.
Willamette Valley ponderosa pine (native) <i>Pinus ponderosa</i> var. <i>benthamiana</i>	60-80 ft.	25-40 ft.	Full sun	Evergreen	Native to Oregon. This Ponderosa Pine does well in Portland's dry summers and wet winters.
Douglas-fir (native) <i>Pseudotsuga menziesii</i>	80-100 ft.	40-50 ft.	Full sun, tolerant of clay soil	Evergreen	Native to Oregon.
Swamp white oak <i>Quercus bicolor</i>	50-75 ft.	40-50 ft.	Full sun to part shade, tolerates clay soils		Useful in lawns and wet soils. Drought tolerant. Leaves have silvery-white underside.
Oregon white oak (native) <i>Quercus garryana</i>	60-70 ft.	45-60 ft.	Full sun, needs dry summer soil		Native to Oregon. Not suitable for irrigated lawns.
Giant sequoia <i>Sequoiadendron giganteum</i>	70-80 ft.	30-40 ft.	Full sun	Evergreen	This tree grows fast and gets big! Must have enough space to grow.
Aptos Blue coast redwood <i>Sequoia sempervirens</i> 'Aptos Blue'	70-90 ft.	15-35 ft.	Full sun to part shade	Evergreen	Fast-growing evergreen with blue-green foliage and fibrous bark.

American hornbeam <i>Carpinus caroliniana</i>	30-40 ft.	20-35 ft.	Full sun to full shade		Versatile tree and tolerates a wide range of soil conditions. Tolerates shade.
Purple beech <i>Fagus sylvatica</i> 'Riversii'	40-50 ft.	30-40 ft.	Full sun, but avoid southern exposure		Leaves emerge green and turn purple.
Black tupelo <i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	35-45 ft.	20-30 ft.	Full sun to partial shade		Intense fall color. Small white flowers.
Shore Pine (native) <i>Pinus contorta</i> var. <i>conorta</i>	30-40 ft.	30-40 ft	Full sun, well-drained soil	Evergreen	Small growing pine with broad rounded crown.
Vanderwolf's Pyramid Limber Pine <i>Pinus flexilis</i> 'Vanderwolf's Pyramid'	30-45 ft.	10-15 ft.	Full sun	Evergreen	Distinctive pyramid shape. Dark green to bluish green needles.
Emerald Sunshine elm <i>Ulmus propinqua</i> 'Emerald Sunshine'	35-45 ft.	20-30 ft.	Full sun, adaptable to wide range of soils		Pest and disease resistant elm. Dutch Elm Disease resistant. Leaves turn a rich yellow in fall.
