Yearly RJ Training for all PPB Officers.

Year 1 — RJ background and model

Year 2 and beyond — Community Partners

Create a platform for youth to request a restorative justice approach for an incident at their school or community.

City of Portland and PPB coordination with stakeholders to ensure capacity and growth for current RJ programs and report back to PCCEP with an Action Plan
