10-year plan: 1 st quarter progress/2008 goal #1: Move people into housing first	<p>CCEH will discuss one or two goals each month.</p> <p>Goal 1.1: <i>400 chronically homeless people will move into permanent housing with supportive services; of these, 30 will be ages 24 & younger.</i> We are currently ahead of the pace on this item.</p> <p>Goal 1.2: <i>300 homeless families with children will move into permanent housing; 150 will be high resource users.</i> Good progress is also being made on this item. There was discussion around how to increase the percentage of people who are contacted.</p> <p>Goal 1.3: <i>550 homeless households, unaccompanied adults or couples, will move into permanent housing (neither chronically homeless nor accompanied by children).</i> Again, this goal is being exceeded currently. There was a concern that more units today depended on being in a drug or alcohol program. There is high demand for both types of housing.</p> <p>Goal 1.4: <i>Reasonable standards drafted, reviewed with providers and incorporated into program goals; % of persons contacted entered in HMIS.</i> These are being discussed by the Steering Committee. Discussion on low performance on contacting households placed in housing.</p>		Sally will convene a workgroup to work on improving housing follow-ups. Steering Committee will discuss.
