January 2010 Election: Review of Ballot Measures (Steve Robinson, Senior Policy Analyst, Oregon Center for Public Policy)</b> <p>On January 26, 2010, Oregon voters will have the opportunity to participate in a special election on two important state ballot measures – Measure 66 and Measure 67. Census 2010: Outreaching to and Counting Homeless Individuals (Sanjeev Balajee, Multnomah-Portland Complete Count Committee and Marc Jolin, JOIN)</b> <p>Every 10 years, a census of how many people live in our country is taken, as mandated by the U.S. Constitution. To ensure a “complete count” of all residents, particularly traditionally undercounted populations, the Multnomah-Portland Complete Count Committee (CCC) was formed. Co-chaired by County Commissioner Deborah Kafoury and City Commissioner Nick Fish, CCC aims to increase the participation of traditionally under/uncounted individuals in the 2010 Census. Mr. Balajee and Mr. Jolin will provide updates on the committee’s efforts to outreach to and count homeless individuals and families in our community.</p>	4:10-4:40
