Bond Stakeholder Advisory Group (SAG) Description of Framework Plan Deliverables

I. Guiding Principles

The SAG will establish a set of principles that describe the shared values and aspirations guiding Bond investments.

II. Policy, Population and Location Priorities

Currently, our overarching goal with Bond funds is to produce **1,300 new units of affordable housing**. The SAG will generate policy, population and location priorities to guide investment of Bond funds.

III. Acquisition and Development Guidelines

The SAG will generate and prioritize recommendations that will assist in decision-making on acquisition and development opportunities. The guidelines will help PHB weigh potentially competing Bond goals and priorities.

IV. Guidelines for Development, Operations, and Programming

The SAG will generate recommendations to guide operations and programming for Bond-funded housing. This will include programming strategies, property management, resident and support services, and partnership/leveraging opportunities.

V. Reporting and Public Engagement

The SAG will generate recommendations for reporting tool(s) and processes to measure progress towards Bond goals to be used by the Bond Oversight Committee. The SAG will also provide recommendations on a plan for public engagement throughout Bond implementation.
