



AFFORDABLE HOUSING BOND STAKEHOLDER ADVISORY GROUP MEETINGS

In November 2016, Portland voters approved a historic general obligation affordable housing bond of \$258.4 Million to fund the development and preservation of affordable housing. A goal of 1,300 units will be produced in 5-7 years. All units will be affordable for households earning 60% Area Median Income (AMI) or below, with 600 units for households earning 0-30% AMI.

The Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) has convened the Stakeholder Advisory Group to establish a community driven Framework Plan to guide goals and decisions for bond funds. The group will meet over the next five to six months. All meetings are open to the public and public testimony is invited.
