All of us should be able to choose where to live. The Analysis of Impediments (AI) to Fair Housing is a process to identify discrimination and other obstacles to housing choice. At this public hearing, the Housing and Community Development Commission will accept public testimony on barriers to fair housing, limitations to housing choice and discrimination in housing in Multnomah County based on race, color, religion, national origin, gender, disability, sexual orientation, marital status, age, source of income and/or family status (the presence of children in the household).

The July 6th hearing will be accessible to people with mobility impairments. Translation services and sign language interpreters will be available upon request. Please notify Ruth Benson, Bureau of Housing and Community Development, (503) 823-2392, (503) 823-6868 (TTY) at least seven days before the hearings if you need these services.
