

SAC MEETING NOTES

Thursday, September 13, 2018

SAC MEMBERS PRESENT:

MEETING NOTES:

1. Chair Boyechko opened the meeting by asking attendees about their summer.
2. Boyechko and Ambroziak reported on a recent meeting with a Community Focus Group. Main concerns raised were formation of a Police Strategic Plan.
 - a. What are priorities for crime reduction and prevention?
 - b. What are priorities for community engagement and inclusion?
 - c. What are priorities to see the Police Bureau become more effective *internally*?
 - d. A full summary of the meeting is not yet available but is forthcoming
3. Chair Boyechko commented that his personal goal is for the SAC to be a bridge between PPB and the Slavic speaking community.
 - a. He added that he hopes to set three goals/priorities
 - b. At the top of his list is more ride-alongs by SAC members by the end of the year
 - i. Burkovskaia offered a forum to share ride along experiences on Slavic Family Radio.
 - ii. Svetlana Pell proposed greater promotion of and visibility of the Cadet Program.
 - c. Chair Boyechko reiterated his intention to focus on identifying three goals and communicating said goals to the community. He also raised the issue of getting more Slavs on PPB
 - i. Pell responded volunteering and internships are a gateway to Slavic community involvement
 - ii. Officer Haunsperger promised to establish an internship position at PPB for Slavic youth.
 - iii. Burkovskaia proposed reaching out to previous volunteers and promoting the internship program to them
 - iv. Pell suggested hiring AmeriCorps members
4. Chair Boyechko proposed *increased SAC member involvement in the Ride-Along program* as Goal 1, and helping PPB recruit more Slavic employees as Goal 2.
 - a. Officer Haunsperger offered to invite more police officers to SAC meetings as a way of increasing collaboration.
 - b. Pell suggested the SAC participate in upcoming *Fix-It Fairs* as a way of gaining greater visibility for SAC in the broader community.
5. Grishkevich gave an update on the Police Rest Stop at his church. There was a consensus we should work on establishing a similar rest stop or two at Slavic churches to enhance communication and coordination between PPB and the Slavic Community.

6. Officer Haunsperger asked for suggestions for topics of discussion at future SAC meetings
 - a. Grishkevich proposed *how PPB can better communicate with various communities* as a topic
 - b. He also proposed greater use of social media as a future topic, to which Officer Haunsperger promised updates to the SAC web page.
