March 2019 BHUAC Votes and Recommendations

Emily Rochon, Program Manager for the Service Coordination Team (SCT), highlighted the proposed changes to the SOP, which included a description of the Supportive Transitions and Stabilization (STS) portion of the SCT program. The committee voted to approve SOP #3-1 with edits.

SOP #3-1 Section: Procedure and Responsibility #3. Additional paragraph as follows:

In collaboration with BHU, SCT offers a direct, service-connected housing for individuals assigned to the Behavioral Health Response Team (BHRT). The goal is to decrease police contact by assertively addressing the needs of individuals with mental health and co-occurring disorders.
