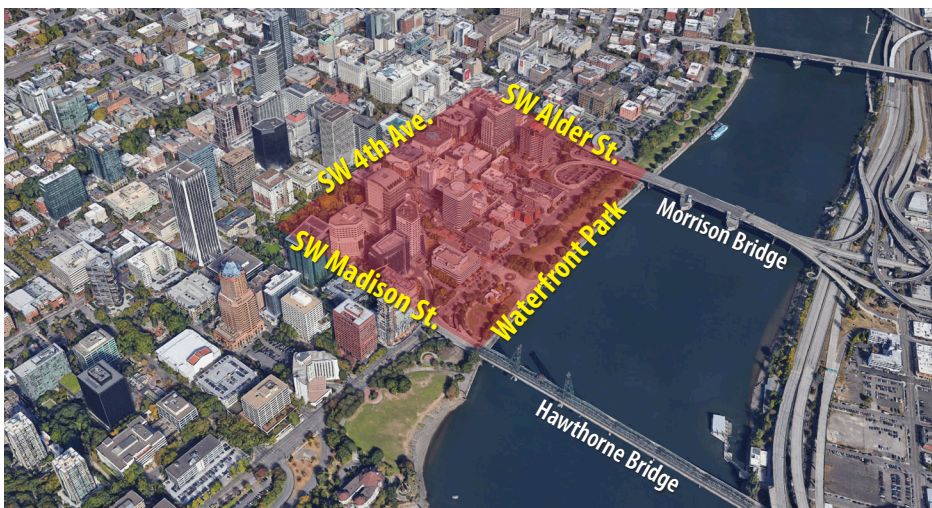


Information and Tips for Demonstrations on August 17

- Several demonstrations are planned for Saturday, August 17 in the downtown core area (See map below for area likely impacted).
- The area of impact is a very small portion of Portland and there are many events happening in other parts of the City that will not be impacted by this event.
- The Portland Police Bureau is working with other law enforcement agencies and non-law enforcement partners to proactively plan a response to these events.
- Life safety is a priority for all during these events.
- You can receive regular updates from the Portland Police Bureau on Twitter, including frequent video situation reports [@PortlandPolice](https://twitter.com/PortlandPolice).
- Check trimet.org/alerts before heading out on transit, or sign up for TriMet service alerts by email or text message at trimet.org/email. If police determine an area has become unsafe, TriMet will adjust their service for the safety of their riders and employees.
- We are encouraging people to avoid coming to the area to observe the events because this presents further challenges for law enforcement officials to do their jobs.
- If you are in the area and witness criminal activity, we encourage you to call 9-1-1.
