## **Case Overview**

### **PPB Case #10-67330**

On Sunday, August 15, 2010, at 1:53 a.m., three officers responded to an apartment complex on Southwest 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue after an apartment complex employee heard an occupant calling for help from one of the apartments. Officers approached the apartment door and heard faint sounds coming from inside. The officers knocked on the door several times and announced their presence. The subject finally answered, but the officers could not understand him. The officers could hear the subject groaning and were worried that he was in need of medical assistance. They opened the door with a complex master key as they announced again they were the Portland Police.

Once inside the apartment, the officers found an adult man lying on the floor naked. As they started to ask the man what was wrong, he jumped up, clenched his fists and screamed at the officers. One of the officers again stated they were the Portland Police and they were there to help him. As one officer was making this statement, the subject charged at the officers. As one of the officers was backing away from the charging man, he was able to Taser the man. The man fell to the floor, but did not follow the officers' directions. At the end of the Taser cycle, the subject became combative, aggressively kicking at the officers and refusing to follow their directions. The apartment was a very small space and the officers were not able to get the subject handcuffed as he fought against their efforts to control his hands and kicking legs. The officers did apply the Taser again and were eventually able to handcuff the man.

After the man was handcuffed the officers were able to evaluate him and realized he was dazed and confused. They saw that he was breathing hard and had a glazed look in his eyes. An officer asked the man if he had any medical conditions. The man was able to tell him he was a diabetic. The officers then requested an immediate medical response to their location.

After medical personnel provided treatment for low blood sugar, the man was transported to the hospital for further evaluation. The subject did not have any injury from the Taser. Being able to quickly get the man handcuffed allowed the officers to discover the cause of his aggression, which turned out to be a medical condition. A prolonged physical fight with the subject could have caused injury to him and delayed the medical treatment he needed.

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stated "Portland Police." Once through the door, we encountered a white adult male lying on the floor and naked. As I started to ask the subject what was wrong, he jumped up with his fists clenched and screamed at us. Again I stated it's the Portland Police and we're here to help you. As I made that statement, the subject came charging at us with his fists balled. Officer Sparks deployed his taser striking the subject in the chest region with the taser probes. The subject fell to the ground, but continued to refuse to follow directions. I then placed the subject in handcuffs. I checked the handcuffs for tightness and double locked them.

Once in handcuffs, we placed the subject on his side in order to prevent positional asphyxiation. The subject stated he was diabetic and seemed to be having a diabetic emergency. I then radioed to dispatch to start code 3 medical. The subject identified himself as Caviness (ME). Caviness stated he must have blacked out because he did not remember getting tazed. Again, I told Caviness that we were here to help him and that medical would be arriving shortly.

Medical soon arrived on scene and began treating Caviness. Medical stated Caviness' blood sugar levels were very low. Medical transported Caviness to OHSU. Prior to medical transporting Caviness, I un-handcuffed Caviness.

Due to Caviness' erratic behavior and the fact that he charged Officer Sparks and myself without being provoked in any manner, I placed a police officer hold on him. I provided a copy of the police officer hold to medical staff. I submitted the police officer hold under this case number.

8. On the listed date and time I was dispatched as a cover Officer to the listed location for a welfare check. Upon arrival we contacted the front desk clerk (KN) Carol who told me that (UF) whom lives in room number 417 has been yelling for help. KN explained attempting to make contact with UF but was not successful as he would not answer the door.

Based on the above we knocked on (UF)'s door but he would not respond to the initial knocks, after several more knocks and announcing ourselves as police UF started to groan. I attempted to communicate with UF asking about his welfare but all he would do is groan. For fear that UF was in some kind medical crisis I opened the door via a key given to me by management.

When the door was opened I saw UF naked laying on the floor, I again announced my self as a police Officer and asked if he was okay. Seemingly out of nowhere UF jumped to his feet and started yelling and running toward me with his hands clenched. UF was running so fast I was not able to even give him directives to stop as he was closing the distance. As I started to back up I was able to deploy my tazer striking UF in the chest. UF fell to the ground but when the cycle stopped he attempted to get up from the floor aggressively. Based on abnormal behavior of UF and the fact that when he fell from being tazed he fell further into his room. Making accessing his person hard. UF's apartment was very small and unknown if it contained any weapons. The entire time I had contact with UF after the first cycle I gave comands for UF to lay on the floor. UF refused these directives resulting in 3 more cycles thus allowing me to enter the room and place handcuffs on UF.

After placing a combative UF in handcuffs I was able to evaluate UF who seemed dazed and confused. I noticed that UF was breathing hard and had a glazed look in his eyes. I was able speak with UF asking if he had any medical conditions. He replied by telling me he was diabetic. Due to UF abnormal behavior I requested code 3 medical who responded. I was notified by AMR that UF had very low blood sugar (count was 40) and this could have been the reason for the behavior. AMR provided UF with insulin after receiving medication UF I spoke with UF who had no recollection of what had occurred. UF was transported to the hospital to be evaluated.

I saw no injuries to UF from the tazer darts that were removed by fire. I placed cartridge number t07-1750986 in property as evidence.
