RE: Results of Signature Verification Process for Initiative Petition "An ordinance to provide health insurance to all children attending the Portland public schools."

On Tuesday, May 27, 2008, you filed signatures to place the above ballot measure on the November 4, 2008 General Election ballot for the City of Portland. After completing circulator certification per Oregon Administrative Rule OAR 165-014-0270, the Auditor forwarded the signature sheets to Multnomah County for verification as required by City Code Section 2.04.090. Per City Code, the deadline for completion of signature verification is 30 days after filing of petition, or June 26, 2008.

I received a certification from Tim Scott, Director of Elections for Multnomah County today. His certification states that the verification results of two random samples of signatures on your petition show that the petition does not contain the required 27,255 valid signatures to refer the measure to the ballot.
