

## One Point of Contact Campsite Report (10/3-10/9/2016)

This week we received 372 new campsite reports via the online form/mobile app, and another 26 emails about various campsites throughout the city. Of those, 122 were reports involving situations where people are living in their vehicles. To date, we have received reports about 325 different vehicles in which people are living.

Springwater Corridor Trial (SCT) Update.

- Yesterday and today, crews are cleaning a Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) property around 117<sup>th</sup>-119<sup>th</sup> and Reedway in which there was a well-hidden, but sizable, campsite crews missed while in the area a couple weeks ago.
- Tomorrow, crews will finish up there and clean the SE 88<sup>th</sup> and SE Lafayette area that was posted on Monday.
- Thursday, crews will re-clean NE Grand and NE Everett as the area was not able to be completed last week.
- Friday, crews will return to Phase 5 of the SCT, starting at the Tidman-Johnson Natural Area and working toward Johnson Creek Park. Additionally, the Brookside Natural will be posted.
- Next week, crews will resume work on Phase 5 of the SCT that runs along the Willamette River once Brookside Natural Area is cleaned (please note- camp cleanup crews cannot work in an area where there is an active resistance taking place).
