

This week (10-16 July 2017), we received 538 new campsite reports identifying roughly 100 campsites throughout the City. Of these new reports, 208 were of people living in vehicles throughout the City. Additionally, 150 of the reports we received this week were reports of camping on Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) properties and rights-of-way, 2 were of camping on Union Pacific Railway right-of-way, and 11 were of camping/squatting on private properties.
