

Greetings-

This week, we received 472 new campsite reports identifying roughly 111 campsites throughout the City. Of these new reports, 138 were of people living in vehicles. Additionally, 122 of the reports we received this week were reports of camping on Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) properties and rights-of-way, 1 was of camping on Union Pacific Railway or BNSF right-of-way, 3 were of camping on TriMet property, and 9 were of camping/squatting on private properties.
