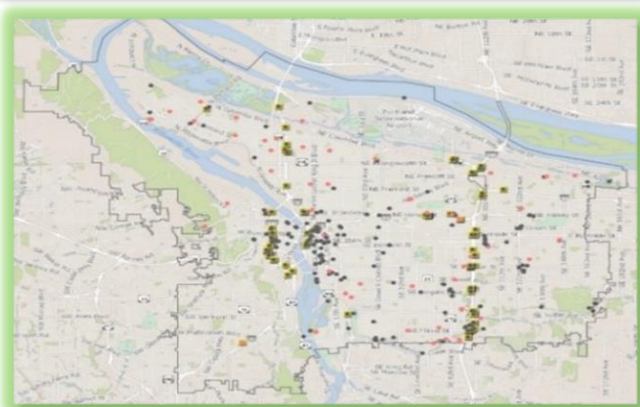
WEEKLY CAMPSITE REPORT

This week we received:

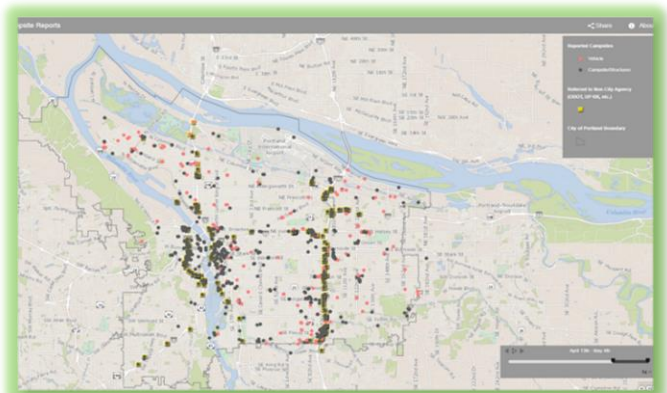
459 new campsite reports identifying roughly 110 campsites throughout the City.
Of these reports:

- 156 were reports of camping on Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) property/right-of-way
- 79 were reports of people living in vehicles
- 35 were reports of camping on private properties
- 2 were reports of camping on BNSF railway property
- 1 was a report of camping on Department of State Lands property

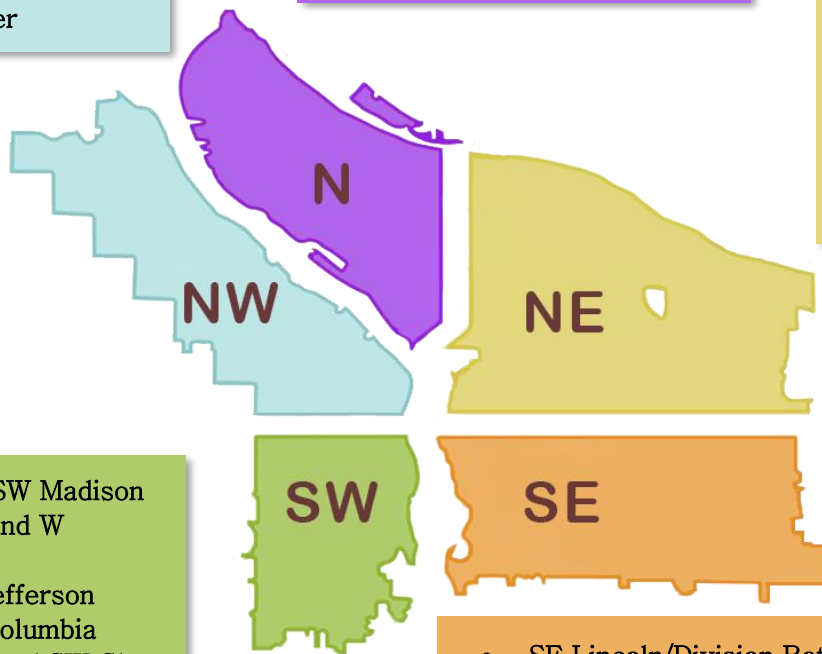

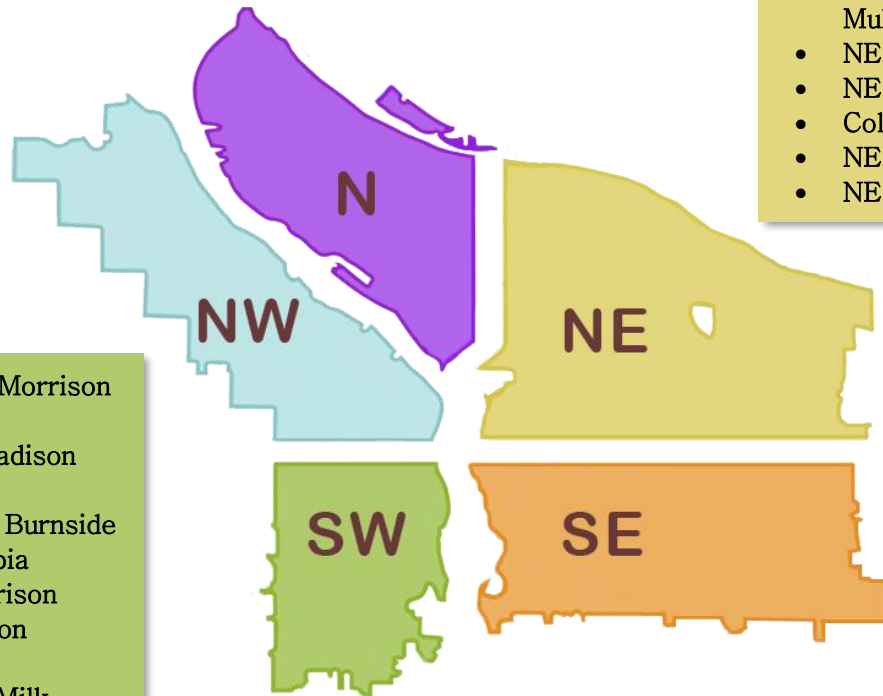

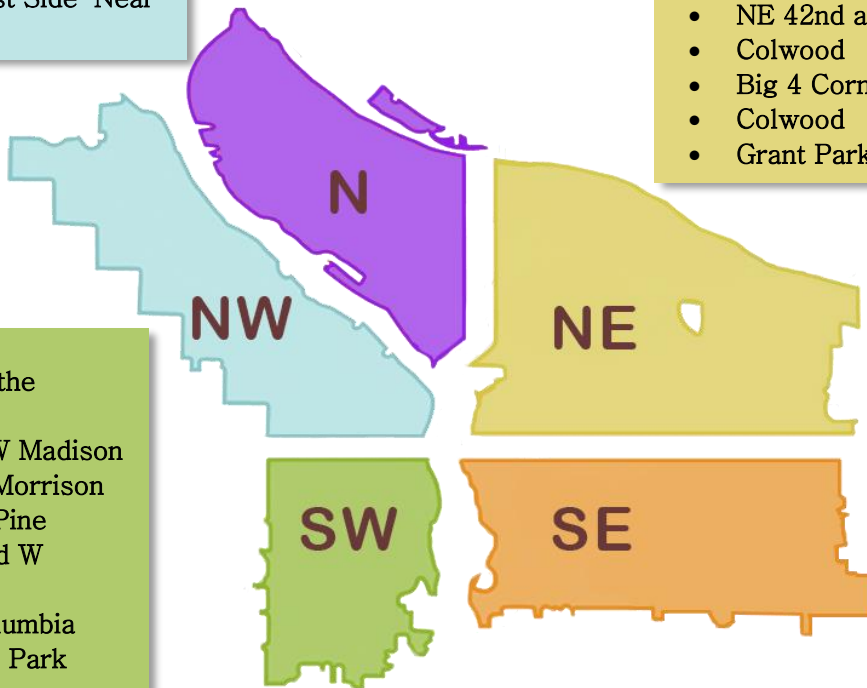
