

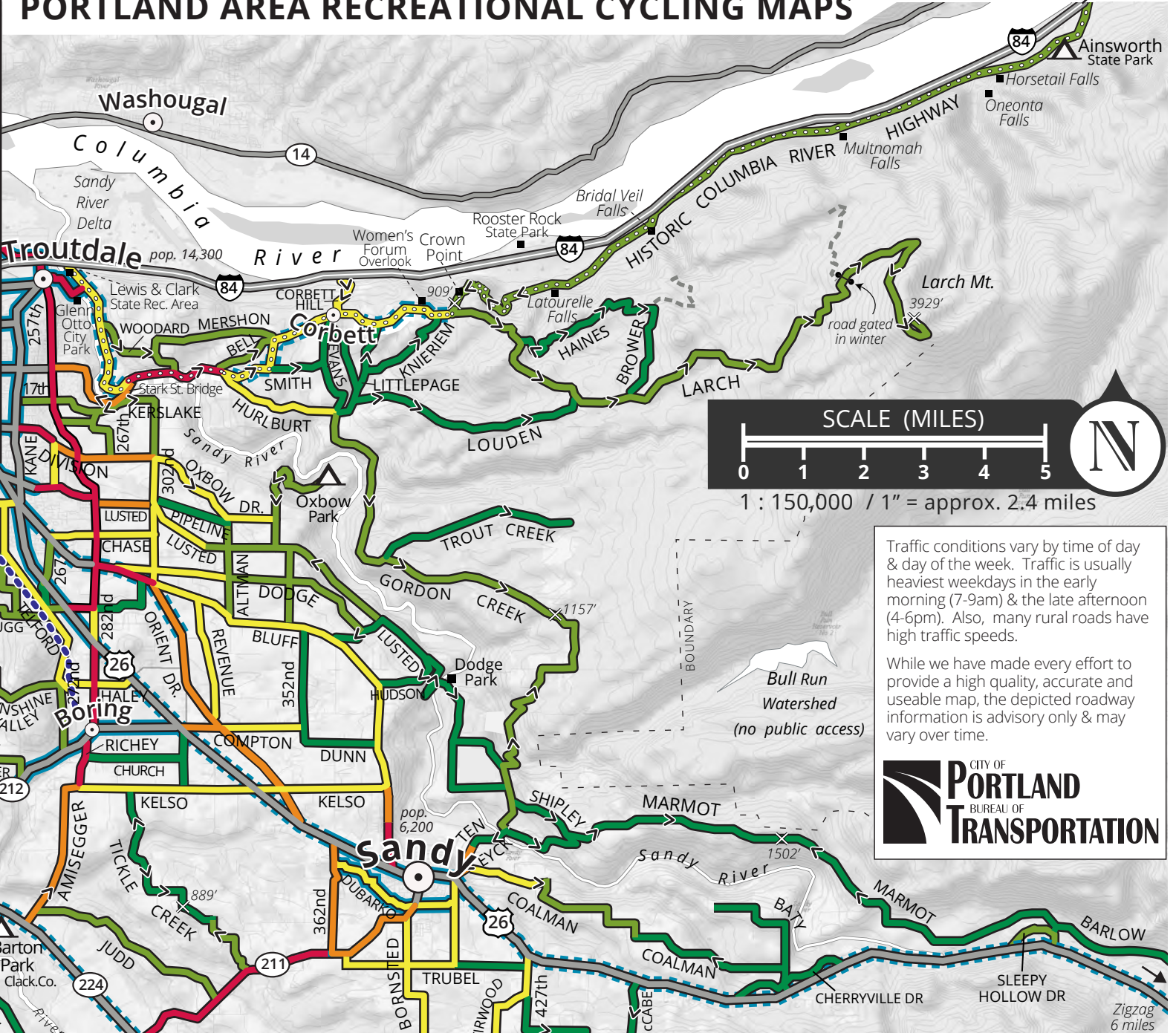
# MAP 11 : SANDY - TROUTDALE
