Existing Conditions

Neighborhoods:	Foster-Powell, Creston-Kenilworth
Segment length:	.3 miles
Avg Daily Traffic Volume:	220
Avg Traffic Speed:	19 - 21 mph
Curb to Curb Street Width:	26- 28 ft
Major Crossings:	SE Foster Rd

Existing Bikeway Character

At Bush St, the Neighborhood Route shifts over to 56th Ave to take advantage of the existing crossing improvements at SE Foster Rd. Low traffic volumes and speeds along this stretch of local streets make it favorable for bicycling.

Key Bikeway Design Issues

- None!

SE Foster Rd at 56th Ave: Recent improvements to this signalized crossing make it safer for bicyclist.

Recommended Improvements

- **SE Foster Rd/ 56th Ave:**
Bicycle detection for existing Traffic Signal
- **Stop Signs: SE Gladstone.**
Stop signs are used to prioritize travel on the bikeway.
- **'Sharrow' pavement markings**
Help bicyclists stay on route and increases driver awareness of the presence of bicycles
- **Destination signage**
Helps bicyclists make connections to the rest of the bicycle network.
- **Reduce speed limit to 20 mph.**
