## Next Steps

- **Summarize the comments and recommendations** we received tonight from all of you and from people who could not attend and sent us comments.
- **Revise and finalize** the draft **Map of Division-Midway Connection Candidates** and other materials presented tonight based on this feedback.
- **Conduct small group interviews** to gather input from targeted communities that have been historically under-represented in traditional public planning processes.
- Work with **students from David Douglas High School English as a Second Language (ESL) class** to conduct survey interviews and learn about the needs and priorities of youth in the study area.
- **Evaluate the connection candidates using the Selection and Project Prioritization Criteria.** These criteria were developed to help evaluate the many candidate connections, identify the most beneficial and feasible connections and set priorities for implementation.
- **Propose potential facility design types that would be most applicable to individual connections,** depending upon the modes to be served, traffic conditions and context. The intent is to provide design options, not determine a single design, for further evaluation at the time of implementation.

- Work with the City staff and **Project Working Group** to review the above materials and develop local street and pathway solutions.
- **Draft a recommended street plan** of local street and pathway solutions in the Division-Midway study area. The plan will also identify key priority connections.
- Hold a **Public Open House in late Spring 2014** to present a draft recommended plan and gather more comments and recommendations from the community.
- **Finalize the Recommended Plan** in June 2014



- Prepare for **City Council Hearing** to Recommend Adoption in Summer 2014.
