



Minor Improvement Permit Application for Voluntary Sidewalk, Curb, and Driveway Repairs

Use this application to apply for a permit to make voluntary repairs to sidewalks, curbs, and driveways that are in the City of Portland's public right-of-way. Permits will usually be ready for pickup on the second business day following the day you submit this application and a confirmation email will be sent once the permit is available. Fees

July 1st 2016 through June 30th 2017

- \$60.00 minimum fee and \$200.00 maximum fee per permit
- \$0.89 per square foot for sidewalk and driveway work
- \$1.22 per linear foot for curb work

July 1st 2015 through June 30th 2016

- \$60.00 minimum fee and \$200.00 maximum fee per permit
- \$0.86 per square foot for sidewalk and driveway work
- \$1.18 per linear foot for curb work

Work Site - A separate application and permit is required for each work site. For example, repairs at two adjacent homes would require two permits, one permit for each home.

Work Amounts - If you are working along more than one property frontage (side of a property along a street) then you will need to separate your work amounts between the different frontages. For example, repairs at a home in the middle of a block would usually have one frontage and repairs at a home at the corner of a block would usually have two frontages. In addition, the work amounts for each frontage will need to be separated between sidewalk, driveway sidewalk, driveway ramp, and curb work. See the drawing on the next page to correctly identify these work types.

Work amounts may be adjusted by City staff as required by City policy and standards. **Please see the last page of this application for more information on identifying and measuring sidewalk, driveway sidewalk, driveway ramp, and curb work.**

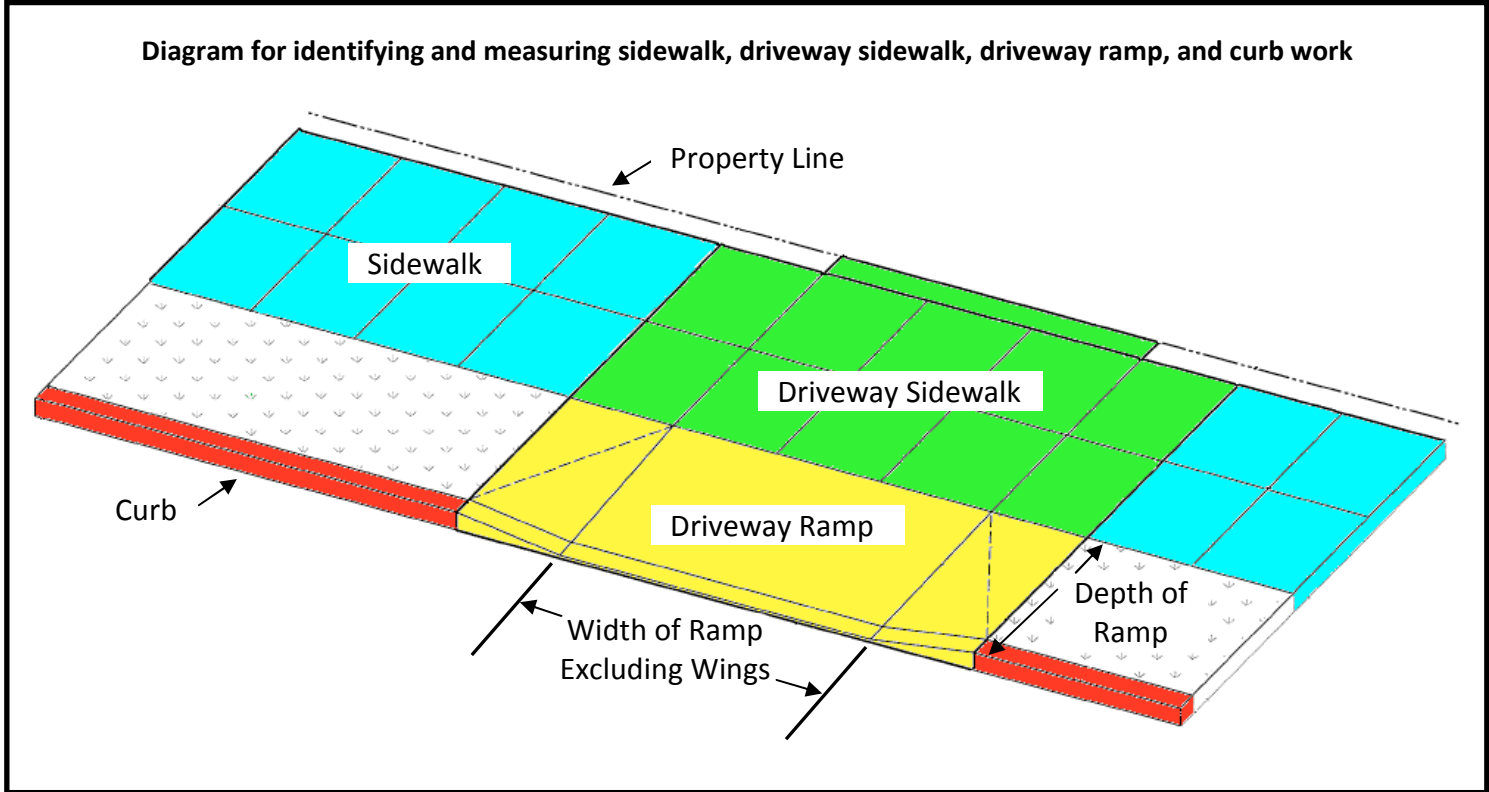
