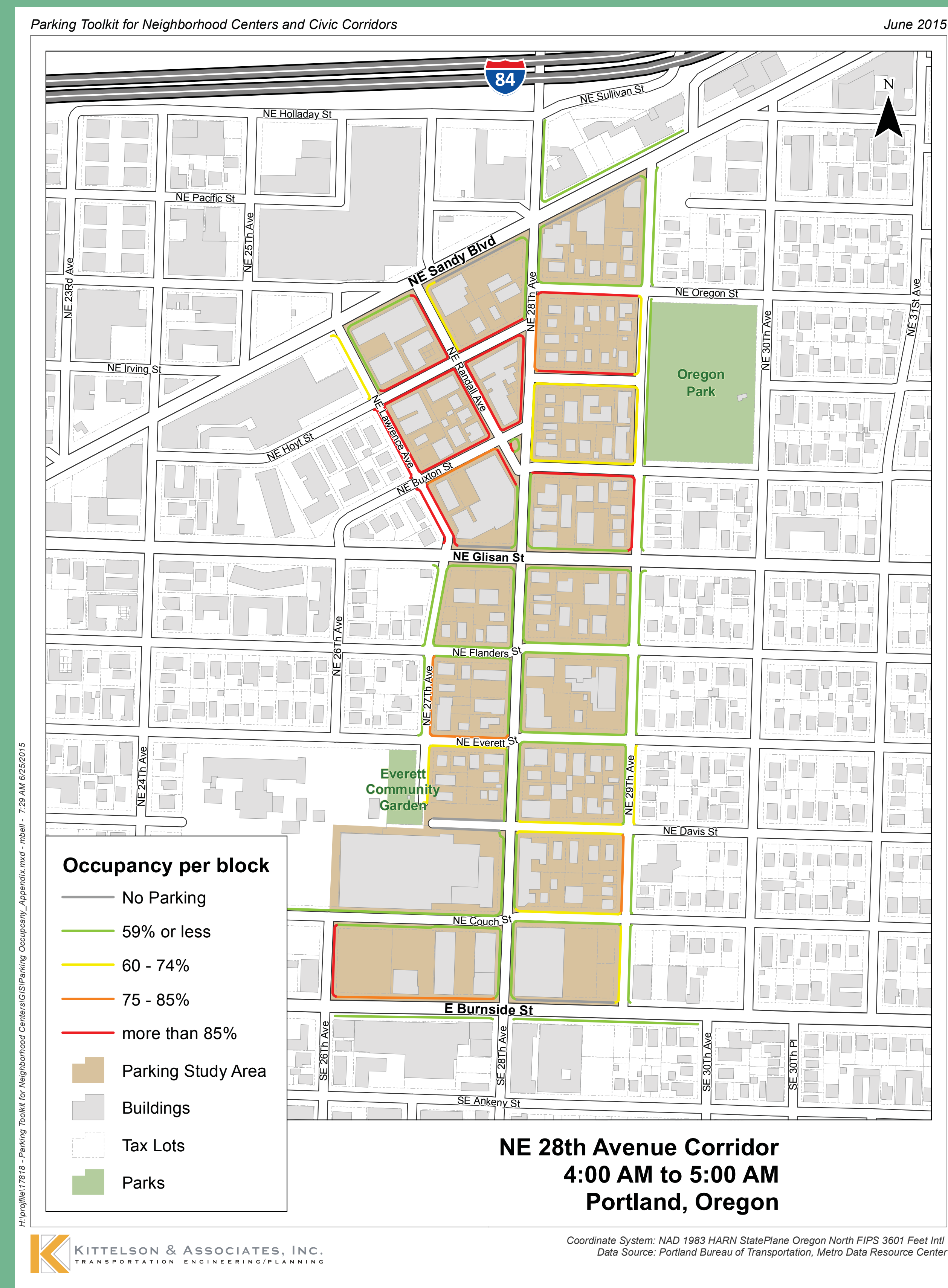


# Centers & Corridors

## NE 28th Avenue Study Area

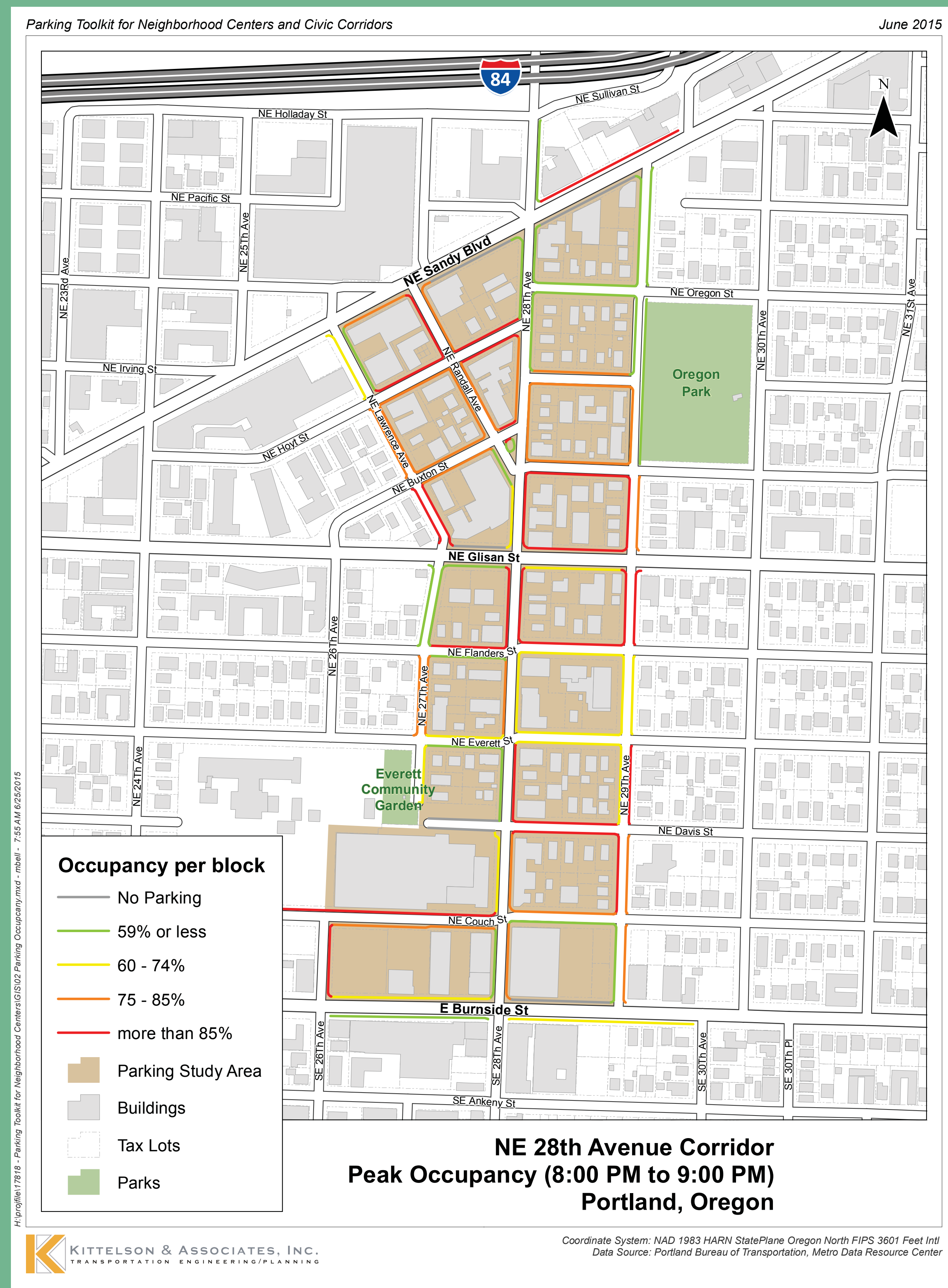
Parking supply and demand data were collected on NE 28th Ave on Tuesday, March 31, 2015. On-street parking occupancy peaked at 71% from 8 p.m. to 9 p.m. Overnight occupancy was 52%. This was the lowest recorded hour.

### Overnight parking occupancy



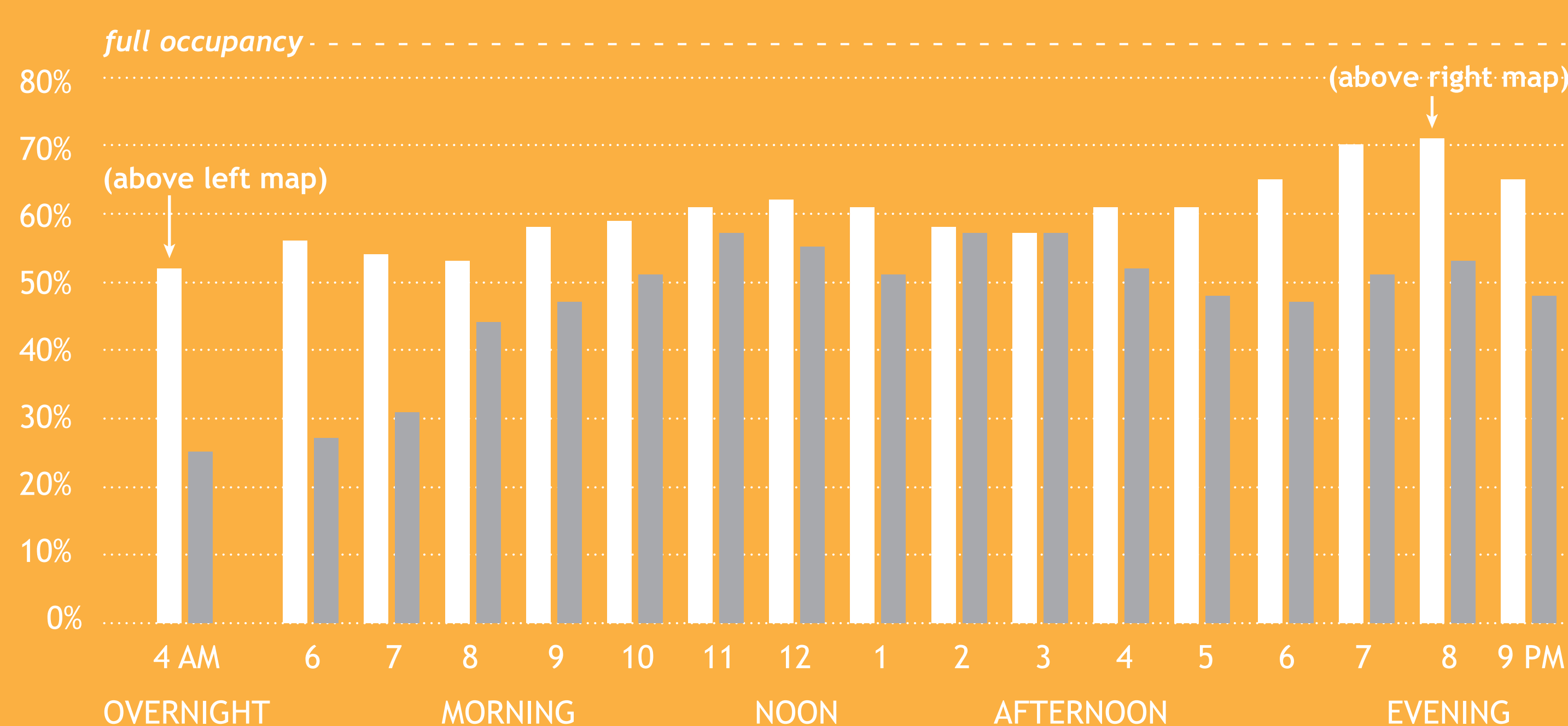
- Occupancy in the overnight hour was 52%
- Overnight vehicles are predominantly residential
- By 8 a.m., occupancy was 53%, indicating many residents leave their cars during the day

### Peak parking occupancy



- Occupancy was 71% in the peak hour (8 p.m.)
- Generally, 85% occupancy is considered "full"
- During the peak hour, 43% of vehicles were residential, the remainder were there for commercial purposes
