An Interim Administrative Rule for tree planting and removal went into effect on April 20, 2015. The City is currently applying the Interim Rule to development projects on City Owned and managed sites and to tree removal permits on private property. The Portland Bureau of Transportation, Water Bureau, Parks & Recreation, Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, Oversight Advisory Committee and Urban Forestry Commission have submitted comments on the Interim Administrative Rule, and now feedback from PAC is also being requested concerning how this Tree Code update could impact Pedestrian spaces.
