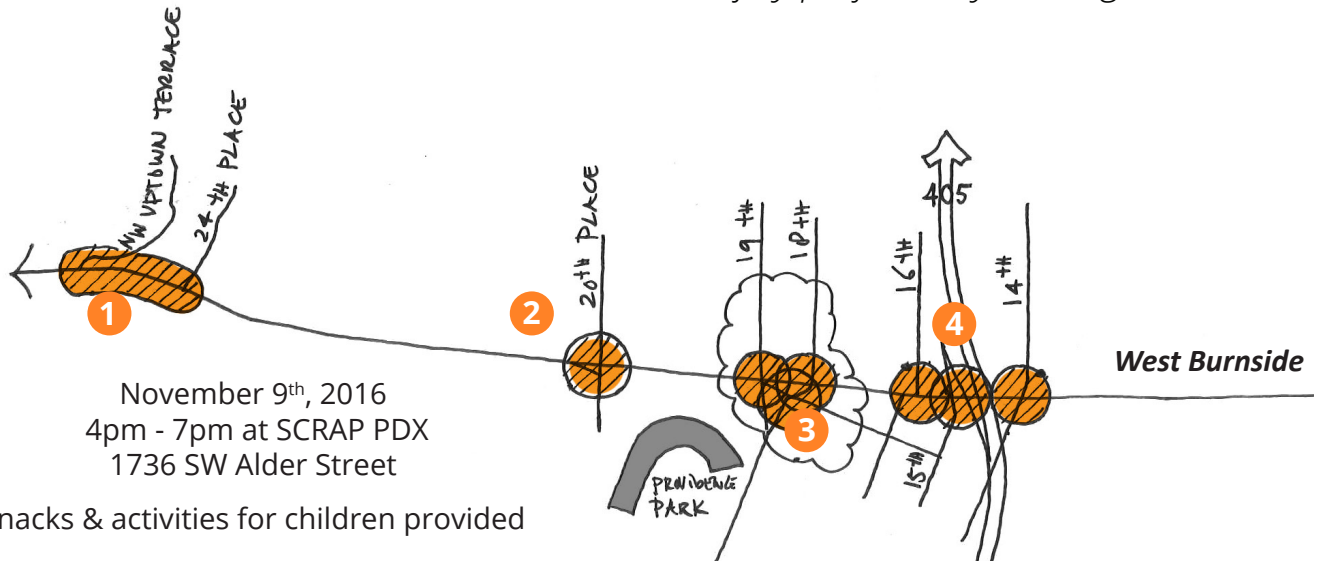


# W BURNSIDE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

## 1 Uptown Sidewalk

A new sidewalk on the north side of W. Burnside Street from NW Uptown Terrace to NW 24<sup>th</sup> Place will be installed along with a retaining wall, with construction beginning the summer of 2017. The project includes 4 new ADA ramps NW 24<sup>th</sup> Place and W. Burnside Street.

## 2 20<sup>th</sup> Place Crossing

This project will install a new traffic signal at the existing marked crosswalk at 20<sup>th</sup> Place, improving pedestrian safety. The project will close the 25ft section of 20<sup>th</sup> Place between Burnside and Morrison, creating a larger plaza and combined TriMet stop. Construction is anticipated 2017/2018.

## 3 W Burnside & 18<sup>th</sup>/19<sup>th</sup>

Based on the West Burnside Multimodal Study, designs have been developed to improve pedestrian and bicycle access across W Burnside at 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> (see illustration). New crosswalks, bike lanes, and vehicle turn lanes will be installed on NW 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> requiring some parking changes. Construction is scheduled for the summer of 2017.

## 4 I-405 Crossing Improvements

Pedestrian crossings improvements across I-405 on W Burnside and NW Couch are funded via the Downtown I-405 Pedestrian Safety and Operational Improvements project. The projects involve new marked crossings, curb extensions, and traffic signal upgrades. Construction is anticipated 2017/2018.
