Bike Parking Code Issues

1. Missing dimensions & update diagrams

- ✓ Updated spacing diagrams (9/29)
- ✓ Depth measurement of 40" added to bicycle footprint (9/29)
- ✓ Two points of contacts required (9/29)
- Spacing of rack intended for 1 bike in building frontage zone
- ✓ Triangular locker layout approved (11/10)

1. Spatial and design requirements for various rack/bike types

- ✓ Reduced footprint for space saving designs, with vertical stagger. Vertical racks and double decker racks. (11/10)
- Cargo bike, trailers, e-bike requirements
- Youth bike accommodations

2. Usability issues

- Prohibit excessive lifting of bikes (revisit at next meeting)**
- Limit the percentage of required bicycle parking that can be satisfied using vertical racks

3. Update location and access requirements

- Short term requirements (trash zones, discuss use of vertical racks)**
- ✓ Long term requirements (accessibility)
- Long term requirements (weather protection, distance from site)
- Signage requirements**
- Lighting**

4. Update security requirements

- Review allowance to place long-term requirement in dwelling unit
