- Green

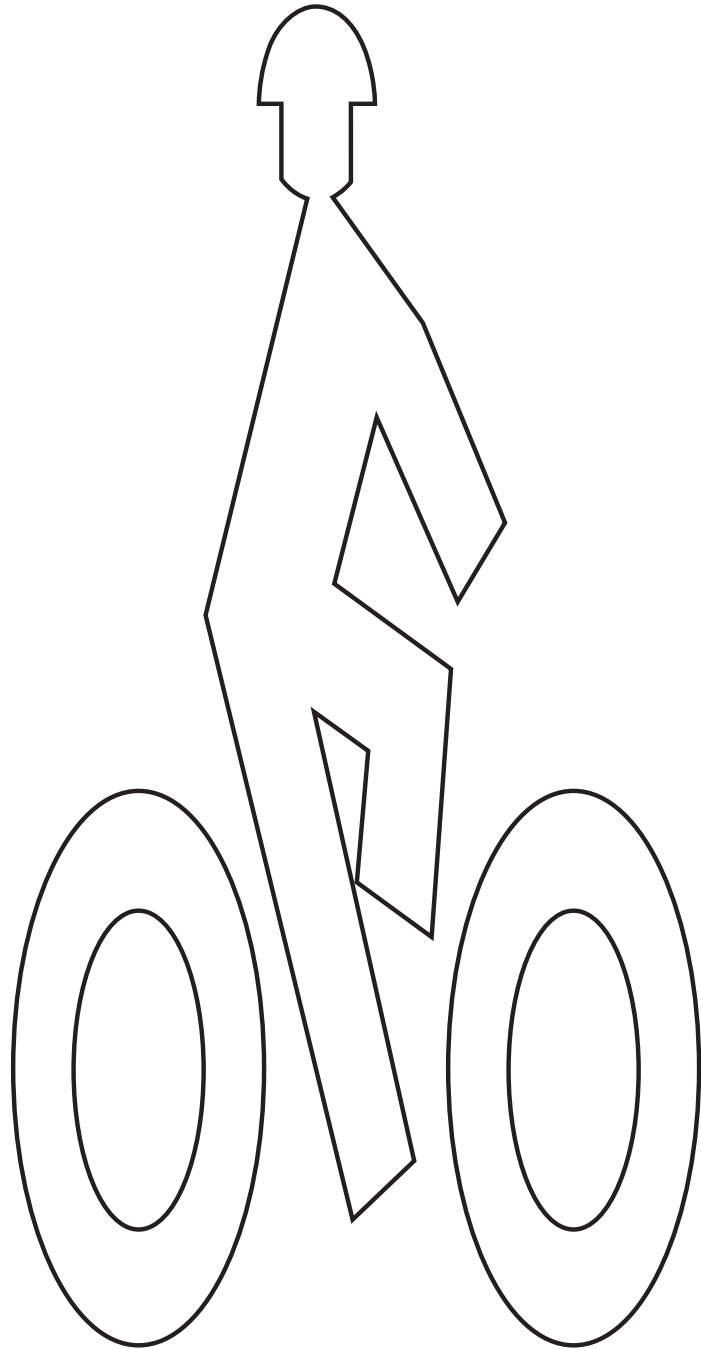
SECONDARY COLORS

CONTEST RULES

- Entry must be the original artwork of children in the following grade brackets: Pre-Kindergarten to 2nd grade, 3rd through 5th grade, 6th through 8th grade, and 9th through 12th grade. Multiple entries are welcome.
- The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) will contact winners by phone or email on or around June 20, 2017 and post winning entries to the bureau website and social media.
- Entries may only be submitted by dropping them in the submission box at any Multnomah County Library. You may enter only by hand delivery. No form of email or other online entry will be accepted.
- By submitting artwork, the Parent/Guardian consents to use of the child's name, artwork and/or quote on materials that promote PBOT programs and activities. If you would prefer your child's name not be used, please initial below.
_____ Please do not include my child's name when publishing my child's artwork or quote.
- Entries will not be returned. Please make a color copy, if desired, or take a photo and share it online using the hashtag *#Biketobooks*.
- There are no monetary prizes associated with winning this contest or for the use of artwork or quotes on PBOT materials.
- Entries must be received no later than Wednesday, May 31, 2017.
- By submitting a coloring, you promise that the coloring page and coloring you submitted: is your original creation; has not been copied in whole or in part from any other work; does not say bad or false things about other people; and has never been previously published or submitted to any other competition.
- Decisions of the judges are final and binding. PBOT and Multnomah County Library will attempt to notify the parents/guardians of winners using the information provided in the coloring page by end of business on June 20, 2017. If a winner's parent or guardian cannot be contacted or does not respond within 48 hours of the first contact attempt, if a winner does not fulfill the eligibility requirements, if a winner does not adhere to the Official Rules, or if the prize notification is returned as undeliverable, that winner will be disqualified and contest organizers may select a new potential winner by the same criteria set forth above.
