Portland's Private For-Hire Transportation Advisory Committee

The City of Portland's Private For-Hire Transportation (PFHT) program within the Bureau of Transportation provides regulatory oversight for the safe, fair and efficient operation of for-hire transportation services. Service operators include taxi companies, Transportation Network Companies (TNCs), limousine and party bus companies, executive town cars, tour operators, pedicabs, non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) companies and horse drawn carriages.

The PFHT Advisory Committee was established by Portland City Council to provide expertise and feedback to the public, PBOT Director and City Council on Portland's PFHT market, regulations and policies, taking into consideration the full range of City goals and objectives. The Committee consists of nineteen diverse members with expertise, knowledge and interest in for-hire transportation in the City of Portland. Advisory Committee members are nominated by the Transportation Commissioner and appointed by Council.

Those with expertise, knowledge and interest in for-hire transportation are encouraged to complete and submit an interest form for one of the nineteen membership positions on the PFHT Advisory Committee. In addition to a non-voting representative from the Portland Bureau of Transportation, Committee membership is open to representatives from the following: the tourism industry, the Portland Commission on Disabilities, an at-large community member with a disability, the riding public, the Port of Portland, TriMet, a taxi company, a taxi driver, a TNC, a TNC driver, an executive town car company, an executive town car driver, a shuttle company, a shuttle driver, a limousine or party bus company, a tour company, a pedicab/Quadricycle company and NEMT company. Committee members serve three-year terms.

Your consideration and interest in serving on the PFHT Advisory Committee is appreciated. Input and insight into Portland's for-hire transportation industry will help to ensure that Portland's evolving PFHT market operates safely, fairly and efficiently.
