6:15-6:45 MAX Orange Line Crossing Safety Update - (Jennifer Koozer, TriMet)

TriMet will be reporting back to the PAC on the crossing safety treatments that were discussed during summer and fall of 2015, and installed in December. These treatments include “switchback” fencing at SE 8th Ave and manual swing gates at SE 11th Avenue. This spring, TriMet and PBOT are monitoring the crossings to evaluate safety and mobility concerns.

6:45-7:15 – Powell-Division Transit and Development Project - (Jennifer Koozer, TriMet & April Bertelsen, PBOT)

This presentation will provide an update of the Powell-Division Transit Project, including potential new options for improved bus service that could begin in 2021. The presentation will review travel time analysis of the previously-preferred route (jogging between Powell and Division via 82nd Ave) that has shown that travel times for trips between downtown Gresham and Portland would likely not improve over current times on Line 4-Division. New options include phased approaches that focus first on Division Street, based on project goal for near-term transit improvement.

7:20-7:40 – How To Google Drive - (Mandia Gonzales, Alta Design)

PAC Member Mandia Gonzales will lead a tutorial on "How to Google Drive". She will provide a basic overview of the common functions as well as showcase where documents are stored on the PAC google drive.
