Dear Residential Building Managers:

To better manage the on-street parking in Zone M, the NW Parking Stakeholder Advisory Committee have recommended the following permit changes to the Portland Bureau of Transportation. The changes to the Zone M permit program will start with the next permit renewal in September 2017.

Residential permit changes coming in September 2017

- The price of a residential permit will change to \$180
- Buildings with 30 units or more will be issued permits at 60% of total units. For example, a building with 100 units can have up to 60 permits.
- All existing permit holders will be able to continue to renew their permits.

Required steps if your building has 30 units or more

1. Complete parking and travel behavior survey at www.nwportlandparking.com
2. Permits will be issued by the City to individuals on a first come, first serve basis.
3. All existing permit holders can continue to renew their permits.

Optional steps if your building has 30 units more

1. Meet with PBOT staff to discuss transportation incentives and information available for tenants
2. Inform residents about transportation information and incentives available at least once annually and for each new tenant during the year.
