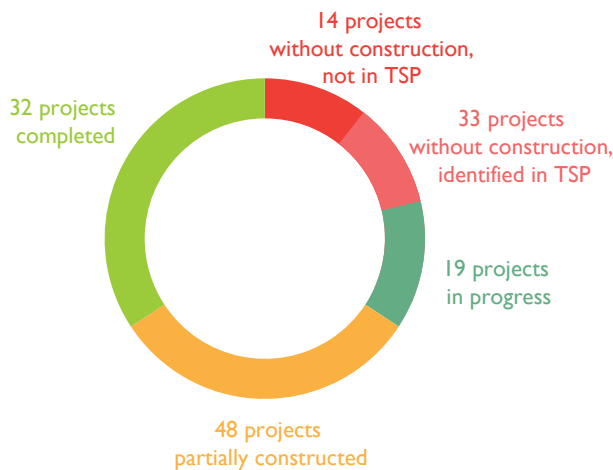

Portland's 1998 Pedestrian Master Plan laid out 146 pedestrian-focused projects that were the result of extensive geospatial analysis and community outreach. PBOT staff conducted an in-depth assessment of this project list to determine the status of these 146 projects and assess how many have been completed to date. As of August, 2017, the status of the 1998 PMP pedestrian projects is as follows:

- 51 of these projects have either been fully completed (31), or are currently funded and in design, engineering, or construction (19).
- Another 48 projects have been partially constructed, with some elements of the described project implemented (because many of the 1998 project descriptions are somewhat vague and call for general "pedestrian improvements," it can be difficult to determine when a project is officially "completed.")
- An additional 33 projects have not been completed, but are identified as a future project on the City's Transportation System Plan (TSP)
- 14 projects have not been completed, and are not on the City's TSP list as a future project.

This assessment will help staff create an updated Pedestrian Master Plan and associated project list. In the coming months, the PedPDX team will conduct outreach and geospatial analysis to determine if those partially completed and uncompleted projects should remain on a list of high-priority projects in the future.
