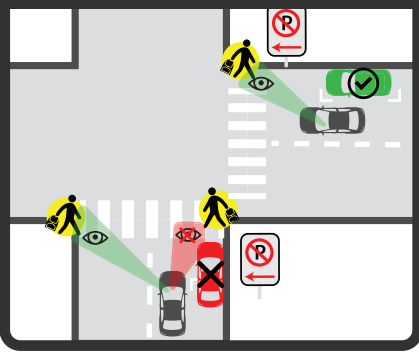


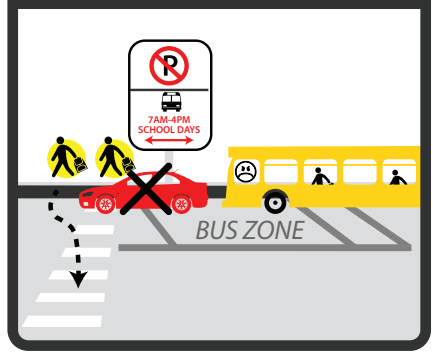
Avoiding these traffic violations will help keep our students safe and improve traffic congestion around school.

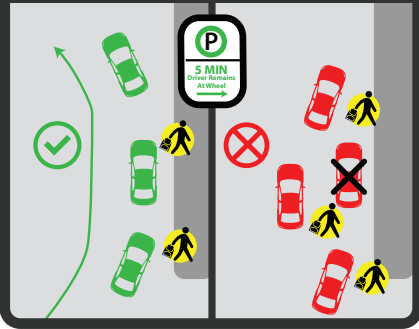
PARKING IN NO-PARKING ZONES



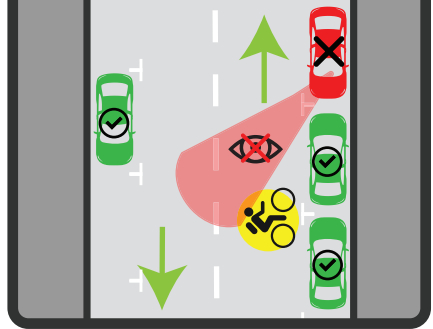
BLOCKING BUS ZONES



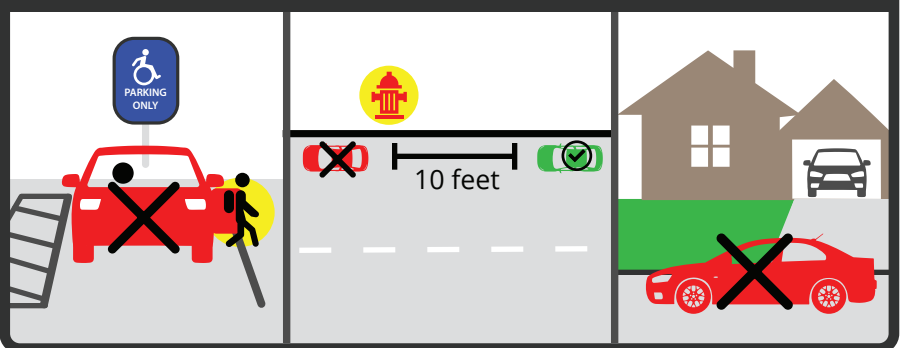
PARKING TOO LONG AND DOUBLE PARKING
