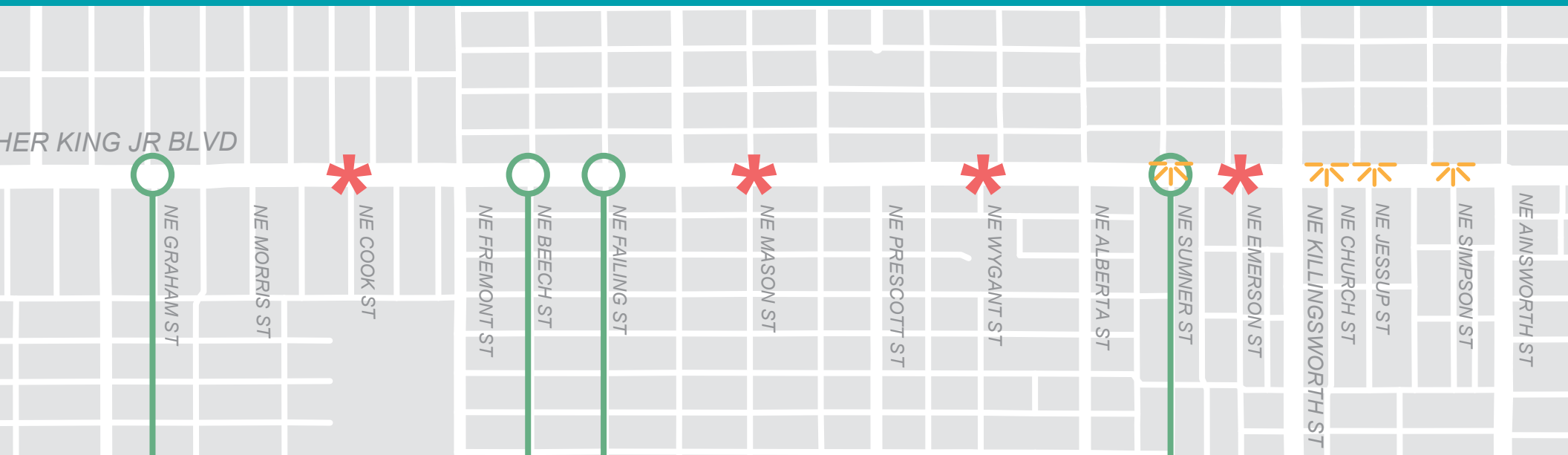


Martin Luther King Jr Blvd Pedestrian Improvement Project

Open house Tuesday September 26, 2017 at King School, 4906 NE 6th Ave, from 5:30 to 7:00 p.m.



Extend median at Graham to existing crosswalk to provide refuge island for pedestrians awaiting safe crossing.

Reduce curb extensions and widen medians to 6' at both Failing and Beech to provide pedestrian refuge space to wait for safe crossing.

Extend median at Sumner to existing crosswalk to provide refuge island for pedestrians awaiting safe crossing.

Removal of one tree in each of these medians to increase visibility of pedestrians who may be crossing or waiting to cross the street.

Upgrade illumination at intersection to increase pedestrian visibility at night.
