**6:30-7:15: PBOT Strategic Investment Strategy** (Shoshana Cohen, Mark Lear, PBOT)

Shoshana and Mark will be presenting a draft 2-year investment strategy and asking the PAC for feedback on the strategy. We'll discuss the major revenue sources over the next two years, including the new state transportation funds, and a proposed allocation strategy. We're looking to see if our strategy resonates and if the PAC thinks we should be considering things that we are not considering. We'll also talk about the timeline for the longer 10-year investment strategy.

**7:15-7:50: St Johns Truck Strategy and Barbur Demonstration Project**

(Rich Newlands, PBOT Project Manager)

Rich will provide an overview of the 60% designs for Phase II of the St Johns Truck Strategy, including various crossing improvements and traffic calming strategies planned for N St Louis/N Fessenden. The project is funded by a \$3.3M federal grant.

Additionally, Rich will provide an overview of the Barbur Demonstration Project. This project received a 2016-2018 Flexible Funds Grant from Metro. However, these funds are currently being reallocated, with input from SWNI. Rich will provide us with an overview of the process to-date and decision-making behind this reallocation.
