Improving safety and comfort for people walking and bicycling in NE neighborhoods, and providing a safe option for people accessing Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.

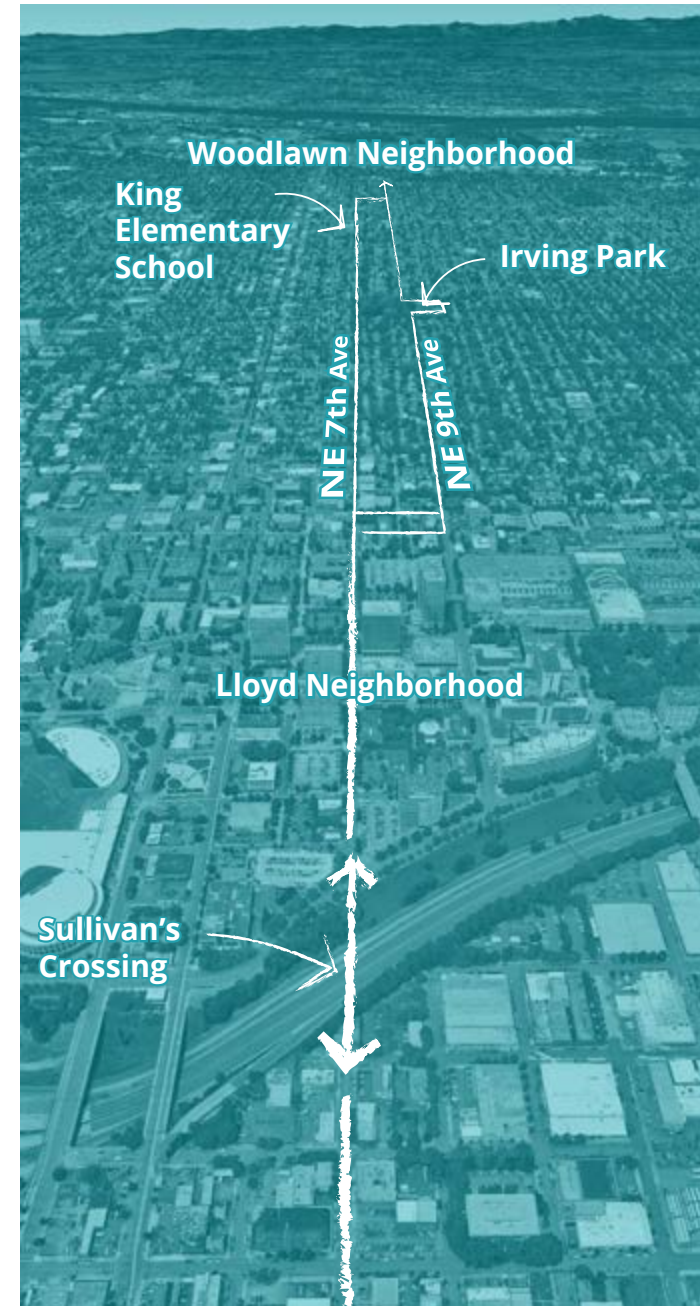
The Lloyd to Woodlawn Neighborhood Greenway Project will expand our citywide low-stress walking and bicycling network in Northeast Portland by creating a safe and pleasant place to walk or bike to employment centers, neighborhood destinations, schools, and nearby parks.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE

- **Design a safe and comfortable route** for walking and bicycling to important destinations through NE Portland.
- **Improve safety and visibility** at intersections and crossings to reduce conflicts.
- **Reduce cut-through traffic** with engineering changes designed to create safe and appropriate motor vehicle speeds and volumes.
- **Reduce the impact of traffic pattern changes** on adjacent arterial and surrounding neighborhood streets.
