### **Connected Centers Street Plan**

Denver Igarta, Supervising Planner for the Complete Streets section in PBOT, will discuss the Connected Centers Street Plan, which focuses on designated Centers in Eastern Neighborhoods (including the Jade District and Rosewood). He is seeking general support for the plan from the committee. The plan outlines a city approach for achieving greater connectivity as development occurs by reducing the required right of way footprint. He is seeking specific feedback on new right of way connection options and sections. There will be a presentation at Planning and Sustainability Commission on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

### **122nd Ave Plan: Safety, Access and Transit**

PBOT is kicking-off development of a plan to identify improvements on 122<sup>nd</sup> Ave, between SE Foster and NE Marine Dr, that will increase safety for all, improve pedestrian & bicycle access and support better transit while balancing needs of freight & other modes. PBOT hopes to make improvements that contribute to removing 122<sup>nd</sup> Ave from the High Crash Corridor network. Changes to be considered will include modifying the street cross-section to include better bicycle transportation facilities, additional enhanced crossings, lighting, signal changes and more to meet these goals. April Bertelsen will be presenting this and is seeking early stakeholder input.
