The **Tillamook Neighborhood Greenway Enhancement** project is a series of safety and design changes between NE Flint and 28th that enhance an essential existing link in our low-stress walking and biking network.

The **Lloyd to Woodlawn Neighborhood Greenway** project will expand our citywide low-stress walking and bicycling network in Northeast Portland by creating a new safe and pleasant place to walk or bike to employment centers, neighborhood destinations, schools, and nearby parks.

TILLAMOOK NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY PROPOSED PROJECTS



1. Marked crosswalk at Flint
2. Marked crosswalk at Vancouver
3. Potential for traffic diversion at Williams with goal of reducing eastbound cars on Tillamook
4. Painted bike box intersection safety design at MLK. Potential for traffic diversion with goal of reducing eastbound cars on Tillamook
5. Speed bumps on 7th to calm traffic
6. Crossing safety design at 21st including new curb ramps, marked crosswalks, speed bumps and raised apron islands
7. Signed crossing at traffic circle on 24th
8. Safety and efficiency treatment on bikeways intersection at 26th

Full length of Tillamook between Flint and 28th:

- Shared roadway markings and signing
- Speed bumps to slow vehicles to 20 mph
- Turn or add stop signs on 10th, 11th, 13th, 18th, 19th, 20th, 26th and 28th to favor greenway
- Parking removal at corners and near projects where necessary for visibility
