Property Owner Notification Requirements for Reserved Parking

Before reserving public on-street parking, advance notice shall be given to property owners adjacent to the reserved parking. This notice shall be provided by the permit-holder, and shall be in written form (letter, email, flyer, posted sign). Evidence of this advance notice may be required by PBOT.

The timeline for this notice depends on the location and type of impact. See below for details.

Reserved Parking that includes Traffic Control; duration of two weeks or longer

14 calendar days advance notice.

Reserved Parking that includes Traffic Control; duration of less than two weeks

48 hours advance notice.

Parking removal in the CBD* requires five business day advance notice.

Reserved Parking Only; duration of five days or longer

48 hours advance notice.

Parking removal in the CBD* requires five business day advance notice.

Reserved Parking Only; duration of less than five days

Advance placement of parking reservation devices a minimum of 24 hours in advance serves as notification.
