**6:30-7:10: Policy Guidance on Electric Scooter Rental (40 min); Steve Hoyt-McBeth, PBOT**

Scooter share is an emerging technology in the shared economy. Since September 2017, four companies have launched e-scooter share systems in the U.S. The scooter share model is similar to dockless bikeshare: scooters are available for checkout in public space for short, one-way trips for a small fee and do not require any infrastructure to complete the trip.

Key questions/issues for the PAC: Staff is asking for the PAC's guidance on electric scooter rental, including evaluation criteria and protecting pedestrian access and safety.
