

2019 PFC Topics

- Regional Flexible Funds (RFF). Need to recommended freight project in the \$3 million range by April. Applications due in late May/early June. The Columbia/Cully Intersection Improvement project appears to be the most ready to advance. Coordinate with the Port on project selection.
- Identity Clark County. Invite Rod Arp and Sean Philbrook to discuss their transportation and business priorities (tentative in February).
- I-5 Bridge Replacement. Invite ODOT and WSDOT staff to provide CRC project recap and status for replacing the I-5 Columbia River Bridge. This is timely as discussions between Oregon and Washington legislatures are taking root.
- Rian Windsheimer, ODOT Region 1 Manager will discuss project priorities (scheduled for March)
- George Middle Schools Crossing Project Update. 60% design expected by March.
- Columbia-Lombard Multimodal Corridor Study. Project kickoff in early 2019. SAC membership makeup TBD.
- I-5/205 FHWA Tolling Application. Invite ODOT staff to provide status update)
- E-Commerce Research Project. This is a component of the Freight Master Plan Update (Sorin and Bob to provide a project update in early 2019).
- Central City In Motion project update and status (Gabe Graff/Kate Merrill)
- PBOT Major Capital Projects Update: NE. Alderwood/Columbia Intersection, NE 47th Ave Roadway Improvements, N. Suttle Road Reconstruction, N. Rivergate Overcrossing, etc. (summer/fall)
- HVUT and Freight Priority project updates (summer/fall).
- Portland Business Alliance: Invite CEO Andrew Hoan as a guest speaker to discuss PBA priorities.
- Oregon 2019 Legislative Updates. The carbon Cap and Invest proposal and additional business taxes will be hot topics issues this session.
- Cornelius Pass Road Safety Project. Project detour scheduled for summer 2019.
- Waste Management CNG truck conversion. Invite Dean Kampher from Waste Management to discuss their experience with converting their truck fleet and Forest Grove fueling station to CNG.

- I-5/Rose Quarter Project. Invite project team to provide update on the EIS phase and project timeline.
- Southwest Corridor LRT FEIS Update. Follow-up on responses to the PFC's comments submitted in July 2018 on the DEIS document. (TriMet/PBOT staff)
- Westside Economic Alliance: Invite CEO to provide an update on key transportation issues and priorities for Washington County.
- North Clackamas County Chamber of Commerce: Invite CEO to provide update on transportation issues and priorities
- Freight Master Plan Update (funding request in PBOT 2019 budget for Phase 1 work - summer/fall topic)
- Northwest In Motion Project Update.
- Portland Truck Loading and Parking Plan: Invite Chris Arms to provide update in implementation plan.
