SW/NW 20th Ave Neighborhood Bikeway

This project will improve conditions for bicycling and walking by slowing auto traffic speeds, reducing auto traffic volumes, upgrading crossings of busy streets, and creating new connections to existing bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure on or adjacent to SW and NW 20th Ave.

Phase I – Complete or In Construction on portions SW and NW 20th Avenues:

- Speed bumps.
- New signage (see image, right).
- New shared lane pavement markings.
- New crosswalks and cross-bikes.
- Traffic diverter at NW Raleigh restricting access to NW 20th.
- New concrete curb extensions at NW Glisan at Couch Park.
- New paint and post curb extensions.



Phase 2 – Construction, Spring 2020

- SW Mill Street Terr to SW Madison:
Shared street for bicycles and vehicles using SW 18th and 17th Avenues.
- SW Salmon to SW Alder:
Bike lanes on SW 16th and 17th Avenues.
- SW Alder from 16th to 17th Avenue:
Two-way bicycle facility on west side of street (see image, right)

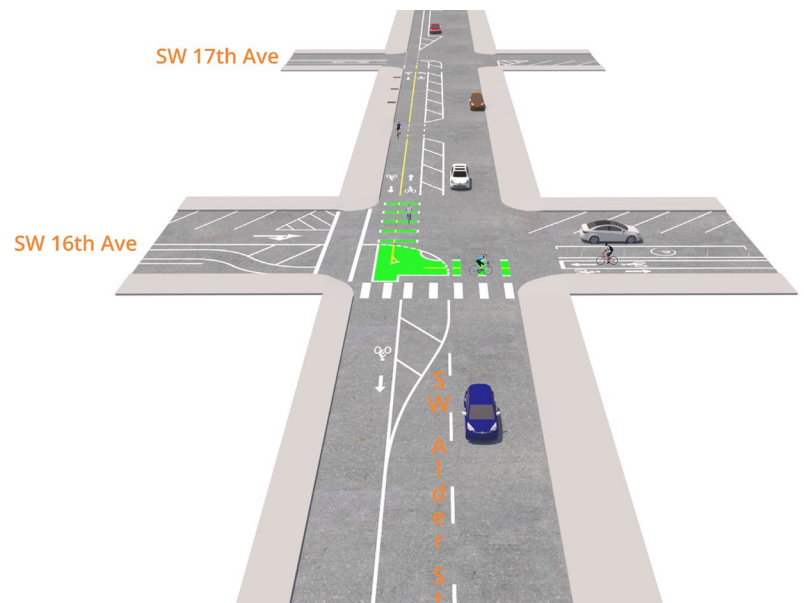
