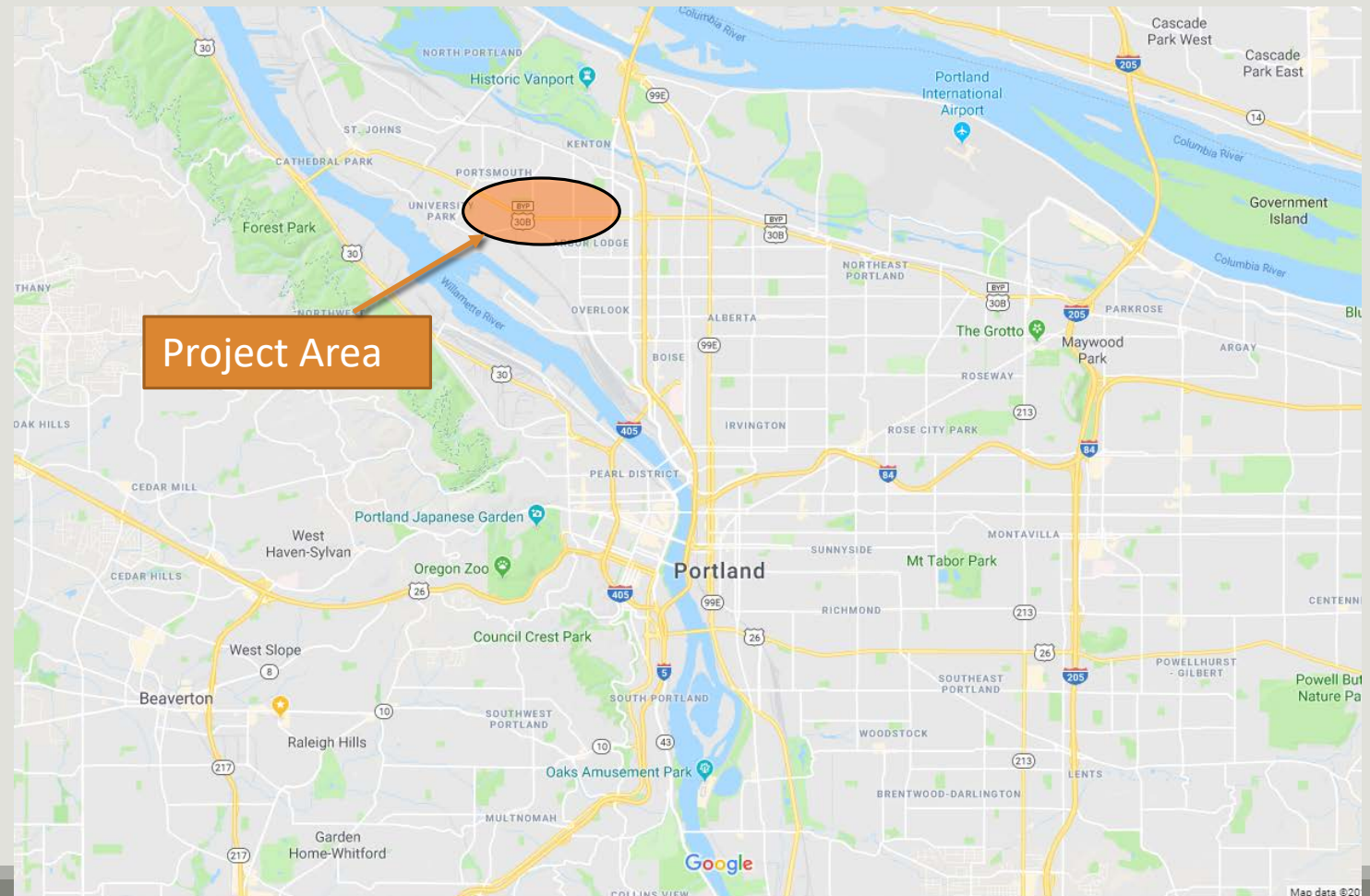

Project Extents



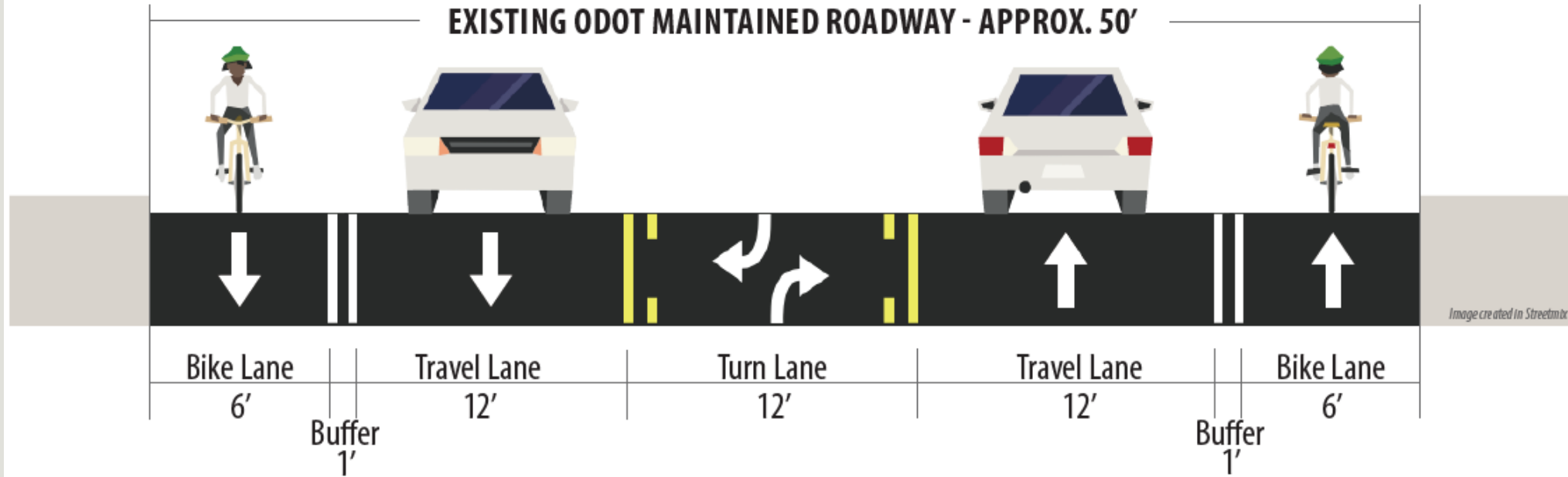
Current Lombard Roadway

The new cross section will look very similar to Lombard Street farther west, like the example snapshot taken at N Van Houten Ave:



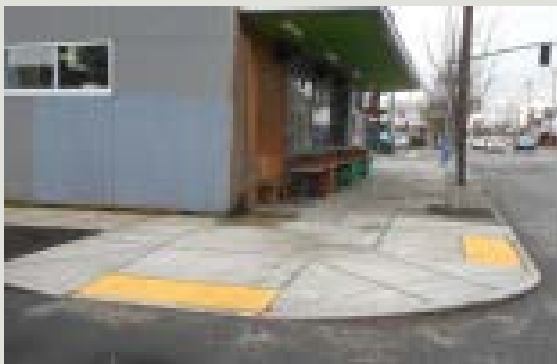
Project Safety Components

ADA Curb Ramps

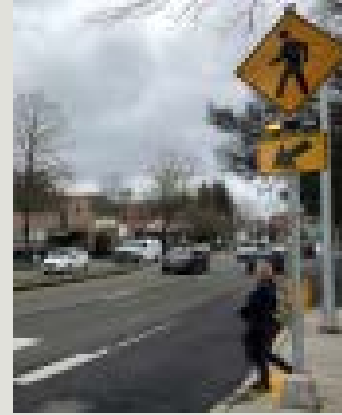


New Paving –

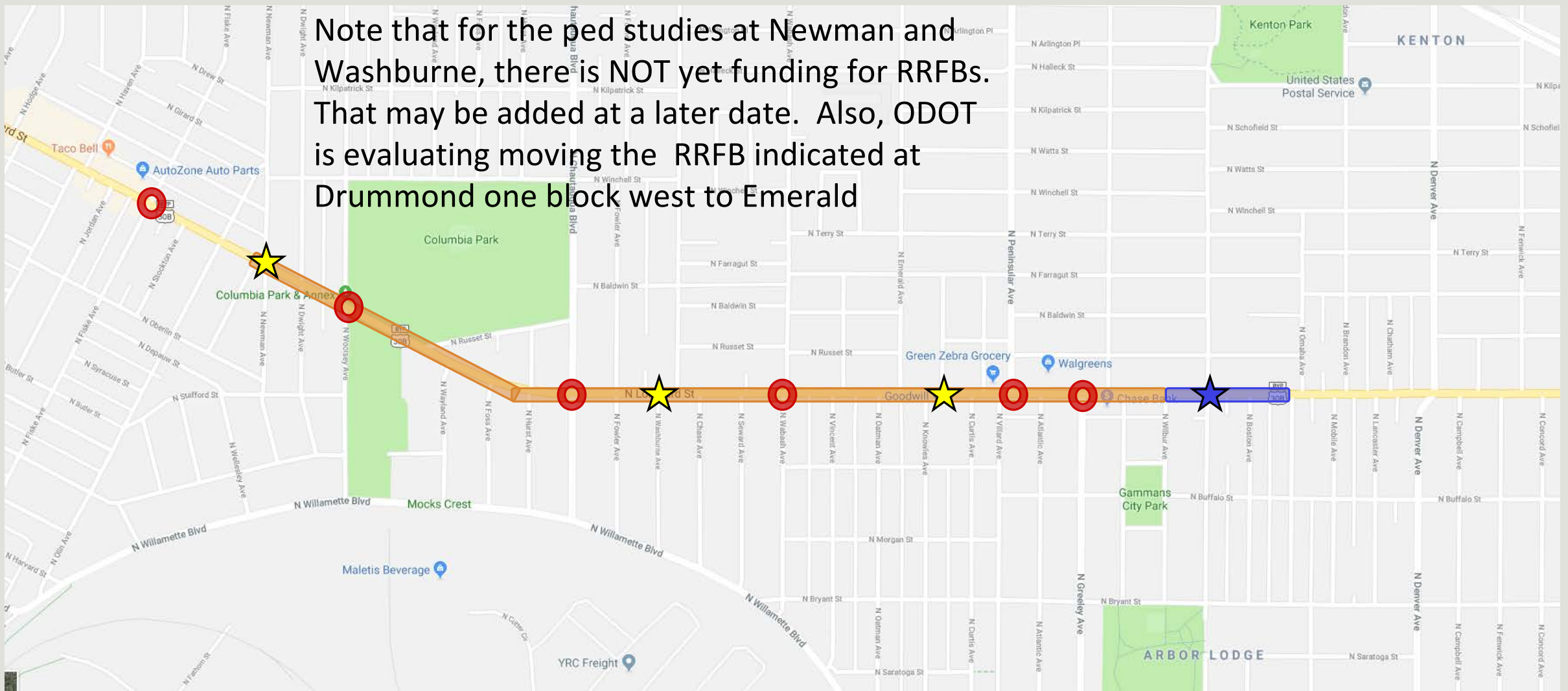

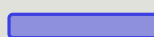
