“Notwithstanding the naming of additional insureds, the said policy shall protect each insured in the same manner as though a separate policy has been issued to each; but nothing herein shall operate to increase the insured's liability as set forth elsewhere in the policy beyond the amount or amounts for which the insured would have been liable if only one person or interest had been named as insured. The coverage applies as to claims between insureds on the policy.
