I. Committee business

Keith Liden, representing the BAC on a stakeholder committee for the Southwest in Motion project (SWIM) discussed a letter he drafted about the project.

Keith noted the letter represents his opinion, which focused on three issues:

1. Implementation of projects is a “big weak spot” in the plan.
2. While the plan identifies potential funding sources there is no identified funding strategy. This uncertainty makes it difficult to determine how much of SWIM can be implemented.
3. The plan should identify how to leverage the Southwest Corridor project for maximum benefit to active transportation in Southwest Portland.

Rithy Khut made a motion to approve the draft letter, allowing for minor final edits. Clint Culpepper seconded.

Committee voted unanimously to adopt the motion.

II. BAC Bicycle Tour

Roger Geller led a tour beginning at Franklin High School that toured newly installed bikeways on Foster Rd, 102nd Avenue and Halsey-Weidler. The tour also rode 92nd Avenue (potential future bicycle lane project) and along the I-205 path.
