



# Portland Water Bureau **COMMERCIAL TOILET & URINAL REBATE**

Replacing older toilets and urinals is a great way to save water and money! The Portland Water Bureau is offering a **\$50 rebate** for replacing older fixtures with high-efficiency WaterSense-labeled tank-style toilets, flushometer toilets, and urinals. **Commercial accounts including businesses, restaurants, schools, and others** are eligible for up to 50 rebates per active domestic water account.

## HOW TO GET A REBATE

- 1 Make sure you are eligible.** Rebates are for active Portland Water Bureau drinking water accounts in good standing. **Limit of 50** toilet rebates per account. Each rebate is worth \$50.
  - 2 Select an eligible toilet.** The toilet you purchase must be a WaterSense-labeled tank-style, urinal, or flushometer toilet. Local plumbing stores are familiar with the WaterSense label. For a complete list of approved models, visit: [www.epa.gov/watersense](http://www.epa.gov/watersense).
  - 3 Save receipt.** A copy of the dated sales receipt (or invoice) is required.
  - 4 Install new toilet.** The new toilet must be installed at the property associated with your Portland Water Bureau account.
  - 5 Recycle old toilet and save receipt.** The old toilet must be recycled at one of the approved recycling centers (listed below). Be sure to get a receipt for the recycling.
  - 6 Complete and sign the toilet rebate form** (see reverse). Application must be received within one year of purchase. Rebate applications for more than \$600 must include a completed W-9 form.  
**Attach the following:**
    1. Toilet rebate form (completed and signed).
    2. Sales receipt or invoice (a copy is acceptable).
    3. Proof of recycling.
    4. W-9 Form if project rebate will be more than \$600.
- 7 Receive your rebate.** Rebates will be posted as a credit to the water, sewer, stormwater account on record for the property. Rebates are processed as they arrive, but it may take a full billing cycle before the credit is posted to the account.
