



Portland Water Bureau **RESIDENTIAL TOILET REBATE**

Replacing an older toilet is a great way to save water and money! The Portland Water Bureau is offering a **\$50 rebate** for replacing an old toilet with a WaterSense-labeled toilet. Residential accounts are eligible for up to two rebates.

Toilet Rebate Eligibility Requirements

- Property must have an active Portland Water Bureau drinking water account in good standing.
- Applicant must purchase a WaterSense-labeled toilet.
- Applicant must recycle the old toilet at an approved recycling center.
- Limit of 2 toilet rebates per account. Each rebate is worth \$50.
- Rebates are available on a first-come, first-served basis. The program will end when funds are depleted.
- Application must be received within one year of toilet purchase date.

Look for the Logo

Only WaterSense-labeled toilets are eligible for the \$50 rebate. WaterSense-labeled fixtures are 20% more efficient than average products in that category and perform as well or better than their less efficient counterparts.

Follow These Steps to Obtain Your Rebate:

- 1 Select an eligible toilet.** The toilet you purchase ***must be WaterSense-labeled***. Local plumbing stores are familiar with the WaterSense label. For a complete list of approved models, visit: www.epa.gov/watersense.
- 2 Save receipt.** A copy of the dated sales receipt (or invoice) is required.
- 3 Install new toilet.** Your toilet ***must*** be installed at the property associated with your Portland Water Bureau account. Random inspections may occur.
- 4 Recycle old toilet and save receipt.** The old toilet ***must*** be recycled at one of the approved recycling centers (*listed at right*). Be sure to get a receipt for the recycling.
- 5 Complete and sign Toilet Rebate Form** (see reverse).
Attach the following:
 1. Toilet Rebate Form (completed and signed).
 2. Sales receipt or invoice (a copy is acceptable).
 3. Proof of recycling.

- 6 Receive your rebate.** Rebates will be posted as a credit to the water, sewer, stormwater account on record for the property. Rebates are processed as they arrive, but it may take a full billing cycle before the credit is posted to the account.
