Short section of SW Terwilliger Boulevard reduced to one lane for sawcutting on Tuesday April 21, 2015

PORTLAND, OR -- A short stretch of SW Terwilliger Boulevard northbound lane at the traffic island on the corner of SW Terwilliger Boulevard and SW Capitol Highway will be closed from 9 am to 3 pm on Tuesday April 21. Both traffic lanes will reopen when the work is completed. Work will be done outside of commute hours.

Flaggers will be stationed to pass traffic through safely. Motorists are reminded to stay alert and use caution as traffic may suddenly stop. Alternate routes are encouraged for motorist to avoid traffic delays.

The contractor for the Portland Water Bureau will be working in the road in preparation for the restoration of the traffic island as part of the SW Carolina Pump Mains-Phase 2 project.
