RE: Tomahawk Well, 55 N. Tomahawk Island Dr., Portland, OR 97217

This is to declare that the property listed above is no longer needed for the Portland Water Bureau system and has been declared surplus. Internal studies by engineering and operations have confirmed this decision. They have recommended that the Water Bureau dispose of this property.

This well and pump house are located on Jantzen Beach in the front yard of the harbor master's residence. They were part of the annexation of the Hayden Island Corporation to the City of Portland in December 1988. This well was built earlier in 1988, but has never been operational for the business of supplying water to the citizens of Portland. The well house measures 280 square feet in size and has not been decommissioned. The City of Portland has permission to access the well using the driveway to the harbor master's home and a Jantzen Beach storage area entrance gate to the north.

I concur with the recommendation to declare this property surplus and dispose of it per the Surplus Disposition and Notification Policy. Your approval to this recommendation is needed. Once you approve, the Water Bureau will notify the City Bureaus and Council offices that this property is surplus and available for acquisition.
